Our performance management program is designed to increase the personal and professional effectiveness of our staff including providing staff with clear performance expectations and developmental opportunities. We provide leaders with the tools and training to enable them to build effective teams and lead successfully including coaching performance and making sound compensation decisions. Decisions regarding compensation programs, as well as individual pay decisions, will be made based on the above objectives as well as the College's financial situation.
