#### Form 990EZ, Part III:

- a. The projects of WOC's **Three Ministries** are the central focus of the organization. The **Ministry of Irritation** works to raise awareness about women's ordination with public advocacy, such as prayerful demonstrations at major Catholics events. This year we continued to host a "Shatter the Stained Glass Ceiling Tour" with a Roman Catholic priest who is facing excommunication for his support of women's ordination, and hosted a number of vigils around the country in his support. Over a hundred people gathered for our vigil in Washington, DC and the story was covered in the National Catholic Reporter. In addition, WOC responded to the Vatican's statements linking women's ordination with sexual abuse, and we were covered in thousands of media outlets worldwide including the *New York Times, CNN*, and the *Associated Press.* The **Ministry of Walking with Women Called** continued to build and coordinate the national network of support. Our Feminist Ministers database was regularly updated to provide members with networking opportunities with ministers in their area. The **Ministry of Prophetic Obedience** provided ongoing support at ordinations for women called to serve as priests and bishops. WOC held multiple film screenings of *Pink Smoke Over the Vatican*, a film highlighting the stories of women called to ordination. The first screening took place in Chicago in honor of WOC's 35<sup>th</sup> anniversary. **Program Service Expenses:** \$35,540
- b. Membership Services and Outreach continues to be an important focus for the organization. To increase general membership, retain our current members, and create overall awareness about the issue of women's ordination, WOC sent representatives to national church reform conferences around the United States, corresponded regularly with members and local leaders, and sponsored advertisements for WOC memberships in publications read by progressive Catholics In February, WOC hired a Membership Coordinator to help build of efforts. Lastly, WOC began researching databases that would help strengthen our work.

Program Service Expenses: \$22,093

c Local organizing and coalition efforts: WOC supports local groups across the country, including Chicago, Cleveland, Philadelphia, Los Angeles, New York City, and St. Louis, in organizing prayerful demonstrations. WOC participates in coalition-building activities with other church reform organizations both nationally and internationally. This year, we continued to organize a "Break the Silence" campaign three other Catholic reform organizations. Coalition efforts also included participation in Women's Ordination Worldwide, an international coalition of groups working on the issue of Catholic women's ordination throughout the world. WOC's Executive Director attended several Steering Committee meetings throughout the year.

**Program Service Expenses: \$14,408** 

- d. New Women, New Church is the magazine of the Women's Ordination Conference and is published three times a year. Each issue is distributed to more than 2,500 members, donors, and subscribers. The newsletter contains information relevant to the issue of women's ordination into an inclusive and accountable Catholic Church. It informs readers about resources available to them and regional events across the country in which they can participate and support.

  Program Service Expenses: \$9,606
- e. Young Feminist Network (YFN) is a group of young Catholic women in their 20s and 30s who work to integrate faith with feminism and eliminate oppression in the church and society This year WOC's online presence was directed at engaging YFN activists. Our Facebook and Twitter accounts constantly provided dialogue. Throughout the year, WOC hosted YFN luncheons to engage YFN members on a personal level.

**Program Service Expenses: \$4,803** 

f. The World Day of Prayer for Women's Ordination is sponsored by WOC each year to encourage U.S. participation in the International World Day of Prayer for Women's Ordination. The national office provided a sample prayer service, organizing tips, and contact information of WOC members to event organizers in local regions around the United States In addition, the national office hosted a vigil outside the Vatican Embassy in Washington, DC, followed by a reception.

Program Service Expenses: \$1,921

g. WOC continued its Racial Justice, Diversity, and Inclusion initiative, which consisted of two-hour trainings and one-day training at the WOC Board of Directors meetings. Throughout the year, WOC's Antiracism met on a monthly basis via conference calls. WOC continued to publicize information on our efforts to create a more diverse and inclusive organization, and made intentional efforts to include people of all ethnicities in WOC's publications and events.

Program Service Expenses: \$7,684
