By enlivening collective consciousness the coherence creating groups help the unfoldment of world peace and harmony. MPP also donated \$1,250,500 to the Global Capital to help with the construction of a new home for MPP in West Virginia. This donation is listed above as part of Expenses.

We averaged 70 participants in the Purusha program in Uttar Kashi in the mountains of India. Located in an ideal setting for focusing on the rapid development of consciousness these participants dedicate themselves to becoming fully enlightened so they can inspire others to unfold full human potential and live totally stress free, blissful and productive lives supported by all the laws of nature.
