Program Service Accomplishments:

In accordance with our mission, the Community Foundation of Broward provides "leadership on community solutions." A key way this is accomplished is through grants. The Foundation strives to award grants that support organizations that:

- Create a better future for the population they serve
- Address a critical challenge or opportunity
- Inclusively unite people, other organizations and resources and
- Produce significant and widely shared results.

This year, \$4.4 million in grants was awarded that supported 605 solutions that transformed lives in our community including:

- Arts and Culture grants that supported youth enrichment programs in schools and within healthcare settings; as well as provided theater arts to diverse audiences.
- Civic Engagement grants for projects that create opportunities for retired professionals to volunteer or work in the social sector to solve problems using their skills and talents.
- Health and Wellness grants that provided support to cancer patients provided HIV prevention education to high risk populations and nutrition programs that feed Broward's neediest residents.
- Education programs that provided a wide range of academic support to improve student outcomes.
- Former Foster Youth grants to agencies that provided comprehensive support and resources to ease the transition from the foster care system to independent living.

Proposals by nonprofit organizations are submitted online through the Foundation's signature software PhilNet: Philanthropy Network for Broward. Foundation staff conducts a thorough review of these proposals that includes research, site visits, interviews of grantee staff and board members as well as experts in the field. This ensures donors and the community that grants are being used effectively to advance prescribed goals.

After review, grant proposals that receive recommendation for awards by staff are presented to a committee of the Board of Directors. This committee queries staff, assures alignment of grants with Foundation goals and makes recommendation to the full Board for approval. The Board members declare conflicts of interest, asks additional questions and approves the final list of grants.

Before checks are presented, a grant contract is signed by the Foundation and the grantee. This contract outlines the projected outcomes and mid and final grant reports required.

Process to determine that scholarship recipients qualify to receive payments:

The Community Foundation of Broward (CFB) holds and administers a number of educational scholarship Funds established by donors. CFB Scholarship Policies ensure that the educational grants meet the requirements of paragraphs (1), (2), or (3) of section 4945(g) of the Internal Revenue Code and the Pension Protection Act 2006-HR4 and are awarded on an objective and nondiscriminatory basis.

Scholarships that are based on financial need require a copy of the parent or adult student's tax return and a formula is used to determine unmet need based on Adjusted Gross Income, number of dependent family members attending college at the same time and other financial resources dedicated for post-secondary education.

Some scholarships have additional specific criteria: course of study, college attending, GPA, citizenship, county of residence, etc. In some cases, an applicant is required to provide a copy of their parents and the student's driver's license, original school transcript and letters of reference as well as any other information needed to demonstrate they meet the criteria.

All applications are reviewed initially by Foundation staff or an appointed committee. Using the above criteria, qualified recipients are selected. The committees then make their final recommendation and present to the Board of Directors for final approval.

Once a student is selected, they are sent an award letter that lists all the required stipulations of receiving the scholarship. They must sign and return acceptance of the award. The scholarship payment is sent directly to the college and the college is instructed as to how the scholarship or money may be used and that any unused portion must be returned to the Foundation. For multi-year awards, students are required to have an official transcript sent to the Foundation before additional monies are sent to the college.

A number of our scholarships are administered through a selection committee in partnership with the Broward Education Foundation who utilizes guidance counselors that focus on college bound students. They abide by the selection criteria for each CFB Fund, conduct due diligence in assessing the unmet financial need, make recommendations of recipients, disburse scholarship Funds to the colleges and universities of each recipient, and handle the annual follow-up verification of enrollment for students with multi-year scholarships. All verification documentation is then provided to the Foundation to release additional years' payments on multi-year scholarships.
