Senior Services includes the Meals on Wheels program and the Animeals on Wheels program. Meals on Wheels delivers hot, nutritious meals to homebound senior citizens. IM delivered 669,500 prepared meals to clients in this fiscal period. The program was serving approximately 4,900 clients at the end of June 2011. The Animeals program delivers pet food to clients with pets. In this fiscal period Animeals distributed almost 40,000 pounds of dog and cat food.

4b (Code:) (Expenses \$ 1,614,631 including grants of \$ 815,950) (Revenue \$ 375)

The Refugee Services program assists in the resettlement of refugees fleeing their homeland in fear of political, social or religious persecution. Services provided include food, housing, transportation and medical assistance; donated furniture, home furnishings and clothing; cultural orientation and employment assistance; translation and educational assistance; and other services designed to help refugees become self-sufficient within six months of arrival in Houston. In this fiscal period, IM resettled nearly 170 refugees from 17 countries.

The Disaster Preparedness and Response program works with nonprofits, religious institutions and government agencies year-round to prepare for disasters. As part of the Disaster Buddy Program, staff works with corporations, congregations and other organizations to recruit volunteer "buddies" who will each be responsible for helping a senior in times of emergency.

The Interfaith Relations program promotes respectful dialogue and meaningful community service for people of all faiths. Features of the program include the Greater Houston Amazing Faiths Project Dinner Dialogues, the Women's Spiritual Retreat, the Interfaith Youth Camp, and the Congregation to Congregation program, engaging hundreds of community members in dialogue, education and service.
