BYLAWS

Of the

TEXAS VETERINARY MEDICAL FOUNDATION

Adopted February 4, 1978
Amended February 2, 1980

ARTICLE I: NAME

The name of this corporation shall be the Texas Veterinary Medical Foundation, herein referred to as the Foundation.

ARTICLE II: MISSION

The Texas Veterinary Medical Foundation shall encourage and use philanthropy to benefit society, the veterinary profession and the animals of Texas through a program of monetary grants. Foundation grants shall be made primarily in the areas of public information, veterinary student scholarships, continuing professional education, animal health and well-being, and veterinary economics, and to support the ideals of the Texas Veterinary Medical Association.

ARTICLE III: OFFICES

The principal office of the Foundation in the State of Texas shall be located in the City of Austin, County of Travis. The Foundation may have other offices, within the State of Texas, as the Board of Trustees may determine or as the affairs of the Foundation may require from time to time.

The Foundation shall have and continuously maintain in the State of Texas a registered office, and a registered agent whose office is identical with such registered office, as required by the Texas Non-Profit Corporation Act. The registered office may be, but need not be, identical with the principal office in the State of Texas, and the address of the registered office may be changed from time to time by the Board of Trustees.

ARTICLE IV: BOARD OF TRUSTEES

Section 1. (General Powers) The affairs of the Foundation shall be managed by its Board of Trustees. No member of the Board of Trustees shall be eligible for a scholarship.

Section 2a. (Number, Tenure and Qualifications) The Board of Trustees shall consist of up to fifteen (15) Trustees, including up to ten (10) TVMA members, four (4) public members, and a Treasurer (see Article V, Section 2). Trustees shall be elected by the Board of Directors of the Texas Veterinary Medical Association at its Annual Meeting for three-year terms each, with terms beginning July 1 of the year in which they are elected and ending June 30 of the year in which their term expires. Terms shall be staggered with two DVM Trustee terms and one Public Trustee term expiring every year. All interim vacancies shall be filled for the unexpired term of such office by majority vote of the remaining Trustees even though the remaining Trustees constitute less than a quorum. The Trustees shall serve until their successors are duly qualified and shall be eligible for re-election one time, serving a maximum of two consecutive terms of office. For the purpose of re-election, service as a Trustee selected to fill an unexpired term does not count toward established term limitations¹.

2b. (Number, Tenure an Qualifications of Emeritus and Honorary Trustees) The Board may elect a total of 25 Emeritus and Honorary Trustees. Advisory Trustees shall be members of the Board, as long as they live, unless they resign. They shall have all the privileges of regular members, except they are not required to attend all meetings of the Board, and they will be non-voting members of the Board. (1991 amendment)

Section 3. (Meeting) The regular annual meeting of the Board of Trustees shall coincide with the annual meeting of the Texas Veterinary Medical Association or at such time and place as the Board of Trustees shall determine. Special meetings may be called at any time by the President, or Vice President, or by a majority of the Board of Trustees.

Section 4. (Notice) Notice of any special meeting of the Board of Trustees shall be given at least ten days previously thereto by written notice delivered personally or sent by mail, electronic mail, or facsimile transmission to each Trustee at his/her address as shown by the records of the Foundation. Any Trustee may waive notice of any meeting. The attendance of a Trustee at any meeting shall constitute a waiver of notice of such meeting, except where a Trustee attends a meeting for the express purpose of objecting to the transaction of any business because the meeting is not lawfully called or convened. Neither the business to be transacted at, nor the purpose of, any regular or special meeting of the Board need be specified in the notice or waiver of notice of such meeting, unless specifically required by the law or by these bylaws.

Section 5. (Removal) Any trustee who is absent at two consecutive meetings of the Board may be removed by the Board of Trustees. (1990 amendment)

Section 6. (Manner of Acting) The act of a majority of the Trustees present at a meeting at which a quorum is present shall be the act of the Board of Trustees. Five members of the Board shall constitute a quorum. In the event that a quorum is not present at a regular or special meeting of the Board, any or all action taken at that meeting shall not be considered binding action of the Board until the minutes of the meeting are approved at the next Board meeting at which quorum is present. (1990 amendment)

Section 7. (Vacancies) Any vacancy occurring in the Board of Trustees and any Trusteeship to be filled by reason of an increase in the number of Trustees, shall be filled by the Board of Trustees. A Trustee so elected to fill a vacancy shall be elected for the unexpired term of his/her predecessor in office.

Section 8. (Compensation) No part of the net earnings of the Foundation shall inure to the benefit of or be distributable to its members, Trustees, officers, or other private persons except that the Corporation shall be authorized to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered.

Section 9. (Action by Trustees when Meeting by Teleconference or by Internet) Any action required by law to be taken at a meeting of Trustees, or any action which may be taken at a meeting of Trustees, may be taken in a meeting held by means of telephonic conferencing or by means of Internet conference technology and shall be binding upon the Foundation when the written minutes of said meeting shall have been approved at the next regular or special meeting of the Board of Trustees.

ARTICLE V: OFFICERS

Section 1. (Officers) Officers of the Foundation shall be a President, a Vice President, a Secretary, a Treasurer, who shall jointly constitute the Executive Committee, and such other officers or assistants as the Trustees may elect. The same person may not hold more than one office simultaneously. The Executive Director need not be a member of the Board of Trustees, a member of the Foundation nor a member of the Texas Veterinary Medical Association. All other officers of the Foundation shall be members of the Board of Trustees.

Section 2. (Election and Term of Office) The officers of the Foundation shall be elected annually by the Board of Trustees at the regular annual meeting of the Board of Trustees, with the exception of the Treasurer. The Treasurer of the Texas Veterinary Medical Association shall serve as Treasurer of the Foundation. If the election of officers shall not be held at such meeting such election shall be held as soon thereafter as conveniently may be. New offices may be created and filled by any meeting of the Board of Trustees. Each officer may serve a maximum of two consecutive terms of office, but shall continue in office until his/her successor shall have been duly elected and shall have qualified.

Section 3. (Executive Director) Whereas the Foundation has the support of the Texas Veterinary Medical Association and whereas, the Foundation has its founding from the

efforts of the Texas Veterinary Medical Association, the Foundation Executive Director shall be the Executive Director of the Texas Veterinary Medical Association. The Executive Director of the Foundation shall not be a member of the Board of Trustees and shall have no vote. The Executive Director shall be generally responsible for the carrying out of the plans and purposes of the Board of Trustees as determined from time to time. He/she shall receive no compensation from the Foundation but may be entitled to reimbursement for traveling expenses incurred in connection with his/her official duties. he/she may be provided with such assistance in carrying out his/her duties as may be required by the volume of work, but all appointments of assistants shall be subject to the approval of the Board of Trustees of the Foundation.

Section 4. (Removal) Any officer elected or appointed by the Board of Trustees may be removed by the Board of Trustees whenever in its judgment the best interest of the Foundation would be served thereby, but such removal shall be without prejudice to the contract rights, if any, of the officer so removed.

Section 5. (Vacancies) A vacancy in any office because of death, resignation, removal, disqualification or otherwise, may be filled by the Board of Trustees for the unexpired portion of the term.

Section 6. (President) The President shall be the principal executive officer of the Foundation and shall in general supervise and control all of the business and affairs of the Foundation. He/she shall preside at all meetings of the Board of Trustees. He/she may sign, with the Secretary, Treasurer, or any other proper officer of the Foundation authorized by the Board of Trustees, any deeds, mortgages, bonds, contracts, or other instruments which the Board of Trustees has authorized to be executed, except in cases where the signing and execution thereof shall be expressly delegated to the Board of Trustees or by these bylaws or by statute to some other officer or agent of the Foundation; and in general he/she shall perform all duties incident to the office of President and such other duties as may be prescribed by the Board of Trustees from time to time.

Section 7. (Vice Presidents) The First and Second Vice Presidents shall perform the usual duties of their office customary in parliamentary procedure, functioning for the President in his/her absence from the chair serving in the order of their seniority. The Vice Presidents shall, in general, perform such duties as may be prescribed by the President.

Section 8. (Secretary) The Executive Director shall serve as Secretary and shall keep the minutes of the meetings of the Board of Trustees in one or more books provided for that purpose; see that all notices are duly given in accordance with the provisions of these Bylaws or as required by law; be custodian of the Foundation records and of the seal of the Foundation and see that the seal of the Foundation is affixed to all documents, the execution of which on behalf of the Foundation under its seal is duly authorized in accordance with the provisions of these Bylaws: keep a register of the post office address of each member of the Board of Trustees which shall be furnished to the office of

Secretary and such other duties as from time to time may be assigned to him by the President or by the Board of Trustees.

Section 9. (Treasurer) The Treasurer shall have the care and custody of all securities and funds of the Foundation and shall deposit such securities and funds in the name of the Texas Veterinary Medical Foundation, in such bank as the Board of Trustees may determine. He/she shall keep books of account. He/she shall submit an annual report, compiled in accordance with generally accepted accounting practices, to the Board of Trustees of the Foundation, showing the whole amount of the real and personal property owned by the Foundation, where located and where and how invested, the amount, nature and manner of acquisitions of all property for which moneys were appropriated or expended. He/she shall submit such other reports as may be required by resolution of the Board of Trustees or by law. He/she shall perform all other duties that usually pertain to this office. He/she shall execute a bond to the Board of Trustees in a sum to be fixed by the Board for all funds and other property in his/her custody, the premium of which bond shall be a charge against the Foundation.

ARTICLE VI: COMMITTEES

Section 1. (Committees of Trustees) The Board of Trustees, by resolution adopted by a majority of the Trustees in office, may designate and appoint one or more committees, each of which shall consist of two or more Trustees, which committees, to the extent provided in said resolution, shall have and exercise the authority of the Board of Trustees in the management of the Foundation; provided, however, that no such committee shall have the authority of the Board of Directors in reference to amending, altering or repealing the Bylaws; electing, appointing or removing any member of any such committee or any Trustee or officer of the Foundation; amending the Articles of Incorporation; adopting a plan of merger or adopting a plan of consolidation with another corporation; authorizing the sale, lease, exchange or mortgage of all or substantially all of the property and assets of the Foundation; authorizing the voluntary dissolution of the Foundation or revoking proceedings therefore; adopting a plan for the distribution of the assets of the Foundation; or amending, altering or repealing any resolution of the Board of Trustees which by its terms provides that it shall not be amended, altered or repealed by such committee. The designation and appointment of any such committee and the delegation thereto of authority shall not operate to relieve the Board of Trustees, or any individual Trustee, of any responsibility imposed upon it or him by law.

Section 2. (Other Committees) Other committees not having and exercising the authority of the Board of Trustees in the management of the Foundation may be designated by a resolution adopted by a majority of the Trustees present at a meeting at which a quorum is present.

ARTICLE VII: CONTRACTS, CHECKS, DEPOSITS AND FUNDS

Section 1. (Contracts) The Board of Trustees may authorize any officer or officers, agent or agents of the Foundation, in addition to the officers so authorized by these

Bylaws, to enter into any contract or execute and deliver any instrument in the name of and on behalf of the Foundation, and such authority may be general or confined to specific instances.

Section 2. (Checks, Drafts, etc.) All checks or drafts or orders for the payment of money, notes or other evidences of indebtedness issued in the name of the Foundation, shall be signed by the Treasurer or an assistant treasurer and countersigned by the President or the Executive Director of the Foundation. Disbursements from any and all funds received by the Foundation and deposited through the Treasurer of the Foundation may be made only as ordered and directed by the Board of Trustees of the Foundation. No disbursements of funds contributed for undesignated purposes may be made without the approval of the Board of Trustees.

Section 3. (Deposits) All funds of the Foundation shall be deposited promptly to the credit of the Foundation in such banks, trust companies or other depositories as the Board of Trustees may select.

Section 4. (Gifts) The Board of Trustees may accept on behalf of the Foundation any contribution, gift, bequest or devise for the general purposes or for any special purpose of the Foundation.

ARTICLE VIII: BOOKS AND RECORDS

The Foundation shall keep correct and complete books and records of account and shall also keep minutes of the proceedings of its members of the Board of Trustees, and shall keep at the registered or principal office a record giving the names and addresses of the members of the Board of Trustees. All books and records of the Foundation may be inspected by any member of the Board of Trustees, or his/her agent or attorney for any proper purpose at any reasonable time.

The Treasurer shall annually have the fiscal records of the Foundation audited by a certified public accountant and said audit reported to the Board of Trustees prior to the annual meeting.

ARTICLE IX: SEAL

The Board of Trustees shall provide a corporate seal, which shall be in the form of a circle and shall have inscribed thereon the name of the Foundation.

ARTICLE X: FISCAL YEAR

The fiscal year of the Foundation shall be July 1 through June 30.

ARTICLE XI: WAIVER OF NOTICE

Whenever any notice is required to be given under the provisions of the Texas Non-Profit Corporation Act or under the provisions of the Articles of Incorporation or the Bylaws of the Corporation, a waiver thereof in writing signed by the person or persons entitled to such notice, whether before or after the time stated therein, shall be deemed equivalent to the giving of such notice.

ARTICLE XII: AMENDMENTS TO BYLAWS

These Bylaws may be altered, amended or repealed and new bylaws may be adopted by a two-thirds majority vote of the Foundation Board of Directors provided the proposed amendment has been:

- (a) Presented to the Board of Trustees for review and opinion.
- (b) Published in a TVMA publication of general circulation at least two months before the Board of Directors meeting at which a vote is to be taken on the proposed change. Upon passage by a two-thirds majority vote of the Board of Directors, the amendment shall be valid and effective immediately.

ARTICLE XIII: ORDER OF BUSINESS

"Robert's Rules of Order, Revised" shall govern the Corporation in all cases to which they are not inconsistent with the Bylaws of the Texas Veterinary Medical Association and the Bylaws of the American Veterinary Medical Association.
