



Form 990-EZ, Part I, Line 20 - Line 20 displays the difference between actual combined funds balance at the end of the taxable year and the funds balance at the beginning of the taxable year less the deficit that resulted from the year's income and expenses. This difference represents a distribution for this year's income to an "untouchable" scholarship endowment fund and an increase in the Scholarship Operating Account. The distribution as made to strengthen the endowment fund, from which the interest fully fund six-ten annual scholarships to needy youth. The increase in the Scholarship Operating Account was necessary due to the reduced income from interest on the endowment fund and other club accounts
