

Healthy Hi Fi – Healthy Hi Fi is a program designed to create a healthier community in and around the Historic Filipinotown community through education, food pantry, direct services, leadership development, cooperative projects and grass roots efforts. The program addresses many issues of health affecting the multi-ethnic Historic Filipinotown area and the larger Filipino American community including issues of hunger and nutrition, occupational health and safety, access to affordable healthcare, substance abuse and more.

COURAGE Campaign – This campaign is aimed at improving conditions in the private home healthcare industry through education leadership development, advocacy and the development of alternative cooperative models PWC addresses the needs of caregivers on many different levels. Through case management, PWC helps with individual issues of wage theft or discrimination. At the same time, PWC educates decision-makers and the general public about the issues of domestic workers with a special focus on Filipino home care workers.
