REVENUE (PRIMARILY SELF-PAY). AS A RESULT, AMOUNTS PREVIOUSLY RECOGNIZED AS NET PATIENT SERVICE REVENUE AND SUBSEQUENTLY WRITTEN OFF AS BAD DEBTS ARE NO LONGER RECOGNIZED AS NET PATIENT SERVICE REVENUE AND ESTIMATED PROVISION FOR BAD DEBTS IN THE ACCOMPANYING FINANCIAL STATEMENTS."

TO FURTHER EXPLAIN DCH'S REPORTING OF BAD DEBT EXPENSE, DCH'S FINANCIAL STATEMENT ACCOUNTS FOR BAD DEBT EXPENSES IN TWO LOCATIONS. FIRST, A DEDUCTION FROM REVENUE LINE CALLED "CONTRA-REVENUE" CONTAINS THE MAJORITY OF DCH'S ESTIMATED SELF-PAY BAD DEBT. FOR FY11, 95% OF TOTAL BAD DEBT WAS MOVED TO THIS LINE. THIS PERCENTAGE IS SIMPLY AN ESTIMATE OF WHAT PATIENT FINANCIAL SERVICES ANTICIPATES WILL NOT BE COLLECTED AFTER ALL DEBT COLLECTION EFFORTS HAVE BEEN EXHAUSTED. THIS ESTIMATE IS BASED ON HISTORICAL INFORMATION. THE REMAINING 5% OF BAD DEBT IS RECORDED IN THE EXPENSE SECTION APPROPRIATELY CALLED "BAD DEBT".

THE FOOTNOTES TO THE AUDITED FINANCIAL STATEMENT REPORT THE AMOUNT OF ESTIMATED UNCOLLECTIBLE SELF-PAY AND EXPLAINS THAT UNCOLLECTIBLE PATIENT ACCOUNTS RECEIVABLE ESTIMATED RESERVES ARE BASED UPON PRIOR COLLECTION HISTORY FOR GROUPS OF RECEIVABLES, KNOWN COLLECTION RISKS AND OTHER ENVIRONMENTAL FACTORS, INCLUDING THE AGE OF THE RECEIVABLES.

REGARDING LINE 3, IT IS IMPLAUSIBLE TO DETERMINE THE AMOUNT OF DCH'S BAD DEBT ASSOCIATED WITH THOSE PATIENTS WHO MAY HAVE MET THE CRITERIA SET FORTH IN OUR FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE POLICY WITHOUT HAVING A COMPLETED FINANCIAL ASSESSMENT FOR EACH PATIENT. WE ARE UNABLE TO DETERMINE OUR PATIENTS' FINANCIAL CIRCUMSTANCES UNLESS A COMPLETED FINANCIAL ASSESSMENT FORM IS VOLUNTARILY PROVIDED TO US. WE CAN ASSERT THAT MORE THAN 90% OF OUR PATIENTS WHO HAVE PROVIDED COMPLETED FINANCIAL ASSESSMENT FORMS HAVE Schedule H (Form 990) 2010 Part VI Supplemental Information

BEEN APPROVED FOR AT LEAST PARTIAL FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE. 16% OF THOSE PATIENTS APPROVED FOR FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE WERE BAD DEBT TRANSFERS. WE FIND IT UNREASONABLE TO APPLY EITHER OF THESE PERCENTAGES TO OUR BAD DEBT POPULATION AS THERE ARE MANY ADDITIONAL VARIABLES THAT MUST BE CONSIDERED.

OUR CFO AND FINANCIAL COUNSELOR ESTIMATES THAT 80% OF TOTAL BAD DEBT EXPENSE WAS ASSUMED ATTRIBUTABLE TO PATIENTS POTENTIALLY ELIGIBLE FOR FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE.

PART III, LINE 8: MEDICARE ALLOWABLE COSTS WERE REPORTED USING DCH'S FILED MEDICARE COST REPORT (C/R). THE C/R USES A COST TO CHARGE RATIO BASED ON A STEP-DOWN ALLOCATION METHODOLOGY. IN CARING FOR THE PATIENT, THERE ARE SEVERAL SERVICES THAT ARE CONSIDERED NON-ALLOWABLE BY CMS SUCH AS: TRANSPORTATION OF A PATIENT, COMFORT ITEMS TO INCLUDE A TELEVISION OR A TELEPHONE. ADDITIONAL NON-ALLOWABLE COSTS INCLUDE THE RECRUITMENT OF PHYSICIANS, PHYSICIAN GUARANTEES AND A PORTION OF THE BAD DEBT (30%) ASSOCIATED WITH THE CARE OF THE PATIENT.

MEDICARE LOSSES, INCLUDING SOME NON-ALLOWABLE COSTS, SHOULD BE COUNTED AS A COMMUNITY BENEFIT AS THIS IS THE COST OF CARE FOR SERVING THE AGING POPULATION. WHILE DCH ESTIMATES A SMALL LOSS ASSOCIATED WITH MEDICARE, WE REALIZE THAT WE ARE AN EXCEPTION DUE TO OUR SMALL SIZE AND THE FACT THAT OUR FACILITY FOCUSES ON OUTPATIENT CARE AND SERVES AS A CRITICAL ACCESS HOSPITAL. OTHER HOSPITALS THAT PROVIDE SIGNIFICANT INPATIENT CARE TO A SICKER POPULATION OF PATIENTS PROVIDE A MUCH BROADER, AND MORE EXPENSIVE, LEVEL OF CARE, AND THOSE HOSPITALS OFTEN HAVE SIGNIFICANT MEDICARE LOSSES.

PART III, LINE 9B: DCH FOLLOWS A STRONG COLLECTION PROGRAM THAT

COMMUNICATES FINANCIAL RESPONSIBILITY TO THE PATIENT. COLLECTION PRACTICES APPLY TO ALL PATIENTS, CHARITY AND NON-CHARITY CARE. THIS INFORMATION WAS REVIEWED BY MSHA'S STRATEGIC PLANNING TEAM, GOVERNMENT RELATIONS, AND QUALITY DEPARTMENTS. THE MSHA STEERING COMMITTEE IDENTIFIED OBESITY AS THE HEALTH DISPARITY TARGETED FOR IMPROVEMENT, INCLUDING THE COMMUNITY SERVED BY DCH.

DURING FY09, MSHA BEGAN COLLABORATIVE EFFORTS WITH EAST TENNESSEE STATE UNIVERSITY'S COLLEGE OF PUBLIC HEALTH TO DEVELOP THE MSHA-ETSU OBESITY COLLABORATIVE COMMITTEE. THE FOCUS OF THIS COMMITTEE IS TO PULL TOGETHER MANY PARTNERS AND ORGANIZATIONS IN COLLABORATION TO REDUCE THE LEVEL OF CHILDHOOD OBESITY THROUGHOUT NORTHEAST TENNESSEE AND SOUTHWEST VIRGINIA.
