	FOSTER CARE SERVICES LFS continues to serve approximately 136 children and youth per night in 130 licensed foster homes located along the front range and eastern plains of Colorado. These children can be referred from any of the 64 counties in Colorado who retain custody of the children while managing their individua permanency plan options which include reunification with biological parents, kinship care, adoption and other planned permanancy arrangements. Beginning in 2008, LFS also began providing foster care for unaccompanied refugee minors (URM) who are referred through the US State Department office of Refugee Resettlement. All services are reimbursed by the federal government and these children/youth can remain in foster care through the age of 21. Once children reach the age of 18, they have the option of entering into one of our Independent Living Programs (ILP) where they can live and practice skills needed to successfully transition to self-sufficient adulthood. They must remain actively engaged in education and/or employment while in ILP. There are now 59 URM youth living in combined LFS foster care and ILP programs.

	REFUGEE RESETTLEMENT SERVICES This program has experienced dramatic growth since 2008 and LFS is the largest resettlement agency in the Rocky Mountain Region. In cooperation with the US State Department, we now welcome 950 refugees to Colorado each year from war torn countries around the world. In addition, we serve up to another 600 "secondary migrants" and Asylees (Asylum seekers) who move to Colorado for family reunification and/or employment from other US cities where they were first resettled. In 2010, LFS also expanded initial resettlement to include the community of Ft. Collins/Larimer Country and we continue to direct the Refugee program for the state of Montana. In 2012, LFS will begin resettlement programs in Albuquerque, New Mexico. In 2010, LFS initiated a Community Work Experience Training Program (CWEP) to strengthen the language skills, job seeking skills and life skills of limited-English speaking participants who are referred from country Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF welfare recipients) programs. The introduction to work activity classes, (averaging 25 participants every 8 weeks), specifically address entry level employment skills in the areas of Commercial Cleaning and Landscaping and have been very successful in accelerating gainful employment opportunities for our graduates.

	CARE MANAGEMENT SOLUTIONS This program provides supportive and educational services for older adults who are living independently and for their care givers, who are most often family members, who assist them on a daily/weekly basis. LFS also provides the only program in the nation that supports care givers in the African American community who are taking care of their aging loved ones. This program is primarily funded by a grant from Denver Regional Council of Governments who identified the unique need for such support in the greater Denver Metropolitan area.

Each level has a low, middle and high pay scale range that is established by a full market review using several well-known salary surveys and "tested" against other non-profit and for-profit organizations in our industry areas. Every three years a full market salary survey is repeated and the levels and ranges are modified accordingly. Every year, a cost of living adjustment is applied to all levels.
