Monies collected from corporate tax credit contributions are directed towards students entering their first year of private education, whether as new kindergarten students or as public school transfer students. To be financially qualified to receive an award, the family's income may not exceed 185 percent of the income limit required to qualify for the Federal free and reduced lunch program.

Arizona state law requires that a minimum of 90 percent of total revenues received be distributed in the form of tuition grants/scholarships. During fiscal year end 2011, CTODP is proud to have distributed 92.7% of contributions received in fiscal year end 2010 to Catholic school students in the form of direct tuition assistance.
