Wasatch Community Foundation Summary July 1, 2010 – June 30, 2011

Statement of Program Service Accomplishments

The Wasatch Community Foundation (WCF) is a volunteer, non-profit organization committed to enriching lives of Wasatch County residents. The strength of the foundation is the focus on four areas: the arts, education, health and recreation to support a balanced lifestyle.

The **Education** Committee is where the largest amount of time and resources are dedicated. Some of its programs are described below:

- 1. Scholarship Program (Amount Expended \$400 96 Students). The Foundation provided scholarships to 88 graduating Wasatch High School students. Board members gather donations from generous community members and charitable organizations and raise funds at the annual golf tournament. The scholarships range in value from \$500 to \$10,000 and are provided to senior students who apply and who will use the assistance towards post-high school education. The Foundation postponed the disbursement date of scholarship checks until after June in order to minimize the chance of students misplacing their check and to allow more time for those students who had not decided on which school they would attend. This is a one-time change. Early in the next fiscal year, \$97,750 was disbursed for scholarships awarded in May 2011. In addition, eight Business Students of the Month received a \$50 check as recognition of their accomplishments, resulting in only \$400 being expended on scholarships in the current fiscal year.
- 2. School Projects (<u>Amount Expended \$24,487</u> 5 schools served). The Foundation uses part of the money raised at the golf tournament to fund projects at district schools. Donations are also received to fund specific projects within the classroom or programs within the schools.
- 3. Career Exploration/Travel Studies (<u>Amount Expended \$5,762</u> students 12 yrs. and older participated). Wasatch County students are given the opportunity to expand their educational horizons by visiting businesses, universities, and conferences where they see the inner workings of the organizations and get additional insight for possible careers. As in past years, WCF sponsored a career exploration trip to New York City to visit the three broadcasting networks for high school students and "Expanding Your Horizons" and "Empowering Your Tomorrow" at Utah Valley University for an introduction into careers in science and math for students in middle school and older.
- 4. Ace Awards Program (<u>Amount Expended \$6.158</u> 14 Educators honored). This program recognizes our local teachers and staff for their dedicated service to our children. Each month during the school year, one teacher and one staff member

are honored with a \$100 check. At the end of the year, a recognition night is held where the community honors each "Ace." From the 14 school winners, one is chosen to receive a \$1000 award as "Educator of the Year" and one runner-up is awarded \$200. Two staff members are chosen that night. One is selected as the "Classified Employee of the Year" and the other as runner-up, each receiving \$1000 and \$200, respectively.

The **Health** Committee offers opportunities for the residents of Wasatch County to improve their health through education and improved facilities. Community health and safety fairs for adults and children, heart disease and stroke prevention education, Red Ribbon week (drug and alcohol prevention) for school children, the community "Issues" conference and the Children's Mile-by-Mile Marathon are specific activities the foundation supports. In March of 2011, Heber Valley Medical Center opened the Women's Imaging Center. Funds from previous years of "Denim and Diamonds" fund-raising events supported this hospital expansion. During 2012, Heber Valley Medical Center will begin a capital campaign to raise funds for a much needed Kidney Dialysis Center. This Dialysis Center will serve patients along the Wasatch Back. (**Amount expended \$59.630** – whole community served)

The **Arts** Committee encourages, fosters, and supports the visual and performing arts in Heber Valley. It contributes funding for local community theatre and musical events. This year, the arts committee sponsored a community arts calendar/brochure for mass distribution listing restaurants and hotels in the area. WCF has plans to sponsor one large event each quarter to promote Heber Valley as an arts destination location. The committee is looking for a long-term arts facility with expansion capability. (**Amount expended \$9,302** – whole community served)

The **Recreation** Committee sponsors Big Brothers Big Sisters mentoring program for at-risk youth. Currently, there are used clothing collection bins in the community, which fund our BBBS program. The committee continues to support the county's new recreation center as more activities and programs are added. (**Amount expended \$20,000** – whole community served)
