Organizational applicants are required to provide written materials that demonstrate clear alignment with desired results, along with a demonstrated capacity to produce and measure the results. Staff and volunteers reviewed the applications, and made funding recommendations that were approved by the United Way Board of Directors. These grants totaled \$2,240,218 for the year. The second way these funds are administered is as an agent to the donor, by qualifying the tax-exempt status of the designated recipient and transferring those funds. Agent-designated funds totaled \$1,602,717 during this year.
