Oregon High School Equestrian Teams is dedicated to organizing and promoting equestrian competition in high school athletic and activity programs. The main goal is to provide recognition in the high schools of the equestrian athlete and to give them an opportunity to achieve that recognition in a fair, positive and educational format. The organization encourages team play, peer acceptance and good horsemanship. OHSET strives to have cooperative adult-supervised leadership for all students in grades 9 through 12.
