NMSF STAFF MUST REFRAIN FROM ANY ACTIVITY WHICH CREATES A CONFLICT OF

INTEREST. THE POLICY IS DESCRIBED IN THE PERSONNEL POLICY HANDBOOK AND IS

MORE RESTRICTIVE THAN THE BOARD POLICY DESCRIBED ABOVE. HOWEVER, ANNUAL
