ALL COMPENSATED INDIVIDUALS LISTED IN PART VII OF THE FORM 990 ARE FULL TIME EMPLOYEES OF THE UNIVERSITY. THE HOURS DISCLOSED ARE THE ESTIMATED HOURS THE EMPLOYEE SPENDS SOLELY ON FOUNDATION BUSINESS. UC SAN DIEGO FOUNDATION EMPLOYEES ARE ALSO ELIGIBLE TO PARTICIPATE IN THE UC RETIREMENT AND 403(B) PLANS WHICH ARE MANAGED BY THE REGENTS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF CALIFORNIA.
