From a small mission school for young men established in 1863, lolani has grown into one of the largest independent schools in the nation. In 1979, girls were admitted to lolani for the first time. More than 1850 students of diverse racial and religious heritage currently attend the school's thirteen grades (K-12) on a 23 acre campus in Honolulu. Iolani School carries out its mission with about 280 full-time faculty and staff which is supplemented by about 700 part-time, seasonal teachers, aides, coaches, and staff for its after-school, summer, performing arts, athletic, and extracurricular programs.
