APPLICATION GUIDELINES

- B. Keith and Norma F. Heuermann created the B. Keith and Norma F. Heuermann Foundation for various purposes some of which were to provide charitable grants for scientific, educational, and charitable applications. The Heuermann's are charitably inclined toward children, the aged, the developmentally challenged, disabled, physically impaired, as well as youth education, and agriculturally related activities. The foundation considers these special needs, among other things, particularly in rural areas in Nebraska, as opposed to charitable organizations located in larger metropolitan areas. Grant requests should consider the following guidelines:
- 1. The Foundation does not use an application form. The Proposal should identify a special need or project to which funds will be applied, including the objectives to be attained, people or groups who will benefit, work plans or timetables for achieving the stated objectives, any other means of support, and the like;
- 2. Grants are made to organizations that are eligible to receive charitable contributions. A copy of the 501(c)(3) letter from the Internal Revenue Service should accompany the application. Individuals are not eligible to receive grants. The Foundation does not authorize loans to grant recipients;
- 3. Grants to organizations engaged in activities in Nebraska are preferred;
- 4. Proposals should be in the range of \$1,000 to \$25,000;
- 5. The proposal may be for a project, which extends over several years; however, the foundation may review and make grants only on an annual basis;
- 6. In the event that a project is to be named for Keith and Norma Heuermann, or have a plaque or other acknowledgment designed in their name, this should be stated in the proposal;
- 7. The grant proposal should be limited to two pages. The foundation board is more concerned with the content than the format of the proposal. Supporting documents such as project budget, other resources, names of supporters, and background information about the organization may be attached to the proposal. Stapled proposals are favored to bound ones. Brevity is appreciated;
- 8. The proposal should consist of five (5) original copies;
- 9. Grant proposals can be made at any time. The trustees convene at least three times per year at meetings to be scheduled in its discretion to review requests for grants. All grant applications will be notified of the trustees' decision after it has the opportunity to review it. Proposals are given careful consideration by the board of trustees of the foundation.
- 10. Grants can be made through the year after the trust board meets. All grant applications are notified of the foundation's decision at that time.
- 11. These guidelines may be revised at any time without prior notice to any previous request for application guidelines.
