## **BY-LAWS**

## **OF**

# **CULLMAN COUNTY FARMERS FEDERATION, INC.**

### **ARTICLE:**

#### I. NAME

The name of the corporation shall be Cullman County Farmers Federation, Inc.

#### II. OBJECT

The object of the County Farmers Federation shall be to create a countywide organization to advance and improve the agriculture of this county; to cooperate with the Alabama Farmers Federation to develop a definite program of work that will bring to this county better economic, social and educational conditions so as to make farming more profitable and country life more attractive.

#### III. MEMBERSHIP

#### Section 1

Active Membership: Any farmer, truck grower, orchardist, or other producer of the fruits of the soil or any lesser or landlord who receives as rent, cash or any portion of the crop produced on the leased premises shall be considered eligible for membership in this County Farmers Federation subject to such provisions and regulations as are herein set forth.

#### Section 2

Family Membership: In the case of families, active membership in this corporation shall be a family membership which shall include the husband, wife, and all children as long as they are dependents of the parents. Each family or individual active member shall be entitled to one vote.

#### Section 3

Associate Member: The Board of Directors of this corporation may establish from time to time eligibility requirements for associate membership in the corporation, provided however, that only persons whose interests (economic or otherwise) are believed to be in harmony with or will advance and further the interests, objectives and purposes of this corporation shall be eligible to apply for associate member status in this corporation. Associate members shall be entitled to all rights of active membership except the right to vote or hold office in the corporation.

- Section 4 Any member wishing to withdraw membership in this County Farmers Federation may do so by informing the Secretary in writing and Receiving from the Secretary written notification of acceptance of withdrawal.
- Section 5 In like manner, this County Farmers Federation by action of its Board of Directors reserves the right to decline or terminate the membership of any person or any persons in this corporation when it is deemed in the interest of the membership as a whole.

#### IV. DUES

The annual dues to be paid by each member of the Cullman Farmers Federation shall be such amount as shall be determined from time to time by the house of voting delegates of the Alabama Farmers Federation in annual or special session, and shall cover membership in the County Farmers Federation, the Alabama Farmers Federation and a specified amount of the membership dues as approved by the voting delegates shall be retained by the Alabama Farmers Federation. In all cases when the annual dues are not paid within ninety days after same dues are due and payable, as provided for above, delinquent members in this County Farmers Federation shall be thereby suspended until such time as membership shall be restored through payment of dues and the action of the Board of Directors of the County Farmers Federation.

#### V. OFFICERS AND DUTIES

- Section 1 The officers of this organization shall consist of a President, Vice President and Secretary-Treasurer to be elected by the Board of Directors of the corporation for a period of one year, and shall serve without compensation until their successors shall have been elected and qualified. Officers shall be elected at the first meeting of each newly elected Board of Directors and the President shall hold office immediately upon being elected.
- Section 2 The President shall perform such duties as usually pertain to this office. He shall have power to call meetings of the Board of Directors and of all committees when he deems advisable; and upon application of three members of the Board of Directors, he shall be required to call special Farmers Federation meetings or meetings of the Board of Directors of the Executive Committee, according to the request of such three directors. He shall, in conjunction with the Secretary-Treasurer, sign all vouchers or checks making disbursements.
- Section 3 The Vice-President shall perform the duties of the President in case of his absence or disability.
- Section 4 The Secretary-Treasurer shall keep full and accurate records of the proceedings of the meetings of the Executive Committee, the Board of Directors, and the Farmers Federation: receive bills, keep records of the membership of the corporation, send out notices of meetings and perform all other duties ordinary to his office.

Section 5 Board members that wish to seek election to the executive committee or an officer position, must report to the Chairman of the Nominating Committee at the Annual Meeting his/her intentions.

Section 6 Term Limits

4 Year limit for President

3 Year limit for Vice-President, Secretary-Treasurer

2 Year limit for Executive Committee (2 members)

Members that serve their term limit will not be eligible to seek a position on the executive committee or serve as an officer for a period of one year.

Section 7 Rotation on State Board – Board members that would like to be a candidate to represent our district on the state board must report to the Chairman of the Nominating Committee at the Annual Meeting his/her intentions.

#### VI. BOARD OF DIRECTORS

- Section 1 The Board of Directors shall consist of 20 directors representing the membership geographically in the county. The chairman of the County Farmers Federation Women's committee and the chairman of the County Farmers Federation Young Farmers committees shall also be members of the Board of Directors constituting a total of 22 directors.
- Section 2 All directors except those from the Women's and Young Farmers committees shall serve for staggered terms of four years. One-fourth of the directors shall be elected each year. Terms of the Women's and Young Farmers committee directors shall be for one year.
- Section 3 The President shall appoint a nominating committee at lease 60 days prior to the annual meeting. The committee's nominations for directors must be submitted at least 30 days before the annual meeting to the full board. Additional nominees may be submitted by petition signed by not less than ten active members of the corporation filed with and received by the secretary of the corporation of the County Farmers Federation office 30 days prior to the annual meeting. A nominee must have been an active member of the County Federation for at least one year before being eligible to serve as a director.
- Section 4 If a director is not to be re-nominated the director must be notified by the president at least 40 days before the annual meeting.
- Section 5 The directors shall give personal attention to the affairs of the corporation in their respective areas of the county, and to keep the membership informed of all promotions and services of the corporation.

- Section 6 A majority of the members of the Board of Directors shall constitute a quorum.
- Section 7 The Board of Directors shall meet at the call of the president.
- Section 8 The Cullman County Farmers Federation board may select life time directors at anytime. They must have been long serving board members and unable to service in a normal capacity. Life time directors are simply complimentary, carrying with them the right to attend meetings and to speak, but not to make motions or to vote. This position is perpetual, unless rescinded and they maintain membership in this corporation.

#### VII. EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE

- Section 1 The Board of Directors shall elect an Executive Committee of five to consist of President, Vice-President, Secretary-Treasurer, and two other directors.
- Section 2 The Executive Committee shall have and may during intervals between the meetings of the Board of Directors exercise the power of the Board of Directors in the management of the regular business and affairs of the corporation, and may have power to authorize the seal of the corporation to be affixed to all papers which may require it. The designation of such a committee and the delegation thereto of authority shall not operate to relieve the Board of Directors or any individual majority of the members of the Executive Committee shall constitute a quorum.

#### VIII. VACANCY

- Section 1 Any director who is absent for three consecutive board meetings shall be dropped from membership on the board, which will create a vacancy. The president will notify the director of his/her removal.
- Section 2 A director with an extenuating circumstance that has missed three consecutive board meetings can remain on the board with the approval of the Directors.
- Section 3 Any director who is dropped from the board cannot be reelected to the board for one year.
- Section 4 Whenever a vacancy occurs in the Board of Directors, other than by expiration of term, such vacancy shall be filled by a majority vote of the remaining directors. The new director shall hold office for the remainder of the term for which his predecessor had been elected, or for a shorter term designated by the Board.

#### IX. MEETINGS

Section 1

Time and place of all meetings of the Cullman County Farmers Federation shall be set by the president and by the Board of Directors. Written or printed notice of all meetings shall be given to each member not less than ten (10) nor more than thirty (30) days before the date of the meeting. Members will be notified by mail, newspaper, radio, telephone or other ways of communications of any Special or Annual Meeting of the County Farmers Federation.

Section 2

At all meetings, members shall vote in person. If a majority of membership entitled to vote be not present in person, then a majority of the Board of Directors together with such other members as may be present in person shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of all business.

#### X. BILLS

All bills payable against the corporation must be approved and signed by the Secretary-Treasurer and President or Auditing Committee appointed by the President before payment.

#### XI. ORDER OF BUSINESS

At all meetings, the following order of business shall be observed:

- 1. Welcoming Remarks.
- 2. Invocation.
- 3. Reading and approving of unapproved minutes of previous meeting.
- 4. Report of Secretary.
- 5. Bills and communications.
- 6. Report of President.
- 7. Report Standing and Special Committees.
- 8. Unfinished business.
- 9. New Business
- 10. Adjournment.

### XII. COMMERCIAL ACTIVITIES

This County Farmers Federation, as an organization, shall not engage in commercial activities. However, it may encourage, promote, and supervise the organization of such activities or industries as may seem necessary and advisable to the Board of Directors.

### XIII. <u>AMENDMENTS</u>

These By-Laws may be amended or added to at any regular meeting or any special meeting of the membership upon the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members present.

#### XIV. PARLIAMENTARY AUTHORITY

The rules contained in the current edition of *Robert's Rules*Order Newly Revised shall govern the society in all cases to which
they are applicable and in which they are not inconsistent with
these bylaws and any special rules of order the society may adopt.
