### ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT AND RESTATEMENT

### SAM AND JUDY LINEART FOUNDATION

(August 1, 2010)

These Amended and Restated Articles of Incorporation supersede and take the place of the heretofore existing Articles of Incorporation and any amendments or restatements thereof of Sam and Judy Linhart Foundation, all pursuant to the Arizona Nonprofit Corporation Act, Sections 10-3101 through 10-11702 of the Arizona Revised Statutes ("ANCA").

### ARTICLE I

The name of the Foundation is Sam and Judy Linhart Foundation (the "Foundation").

### ARTICLE II Purposes

This Foundation is organized and shall be operated exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, literary and scientific purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (the "Code"), or any corresponding provision of any future federal tax laws. The Foundation initially intends to make grants for any charitable, religious, educational, literary or scientific purpose within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Code, including for such purposes as the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Code.

### ARTICLE III Activities and Restrictions

(a) No part of the net earnings of the Foundation shall have to the benefit of or be distributable to its directors, officers, or other private persons, except that the Foundation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article II hereof. No substantial part of the Foundation's activities shall be the carrying on of propagands or otherwise attempting to influence legislation. The Foundation shall not participate in or intervene in

(including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office.

- (b) The Foundation shall distribute its income for each tex year at such time and in such manner so that it will not become subject to the tax on undistributed income imposed by Section 4942 of the Code or corresponding provision of any future federal tax laws. In addition, the Foundation shall not: (1) engage in any act of self-dealing as defined in Section 4941(d) of the Code or corresponding provision of any future federal tax laws; (2) retain any excess business holdings as defined in Section 4943(c) of the Code or corresponding provision of any future federal tax laws; (3) make any investments in such manner as to subject the Foundation to tax under Section 4944 of the Code or corresponding provision of any future federal tax laws; or (4) make any taxable expenditures as defined in Section 4945(d) of the Code or corresponding provision of any future federal tax laws.
- (c) Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, the Foundation shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by a corporation: (1) exempt from income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Code or corresponding provision of any future federal tax laws; (2) contributions to which are deductible for income tax purposes under Section 170(c)(2) of the Code or corresponding provision of any future federal tax laws; (3) bequests, legacies, devises, and transfers to which are deductible for estate tax purposes under Section 2055(a)(2) of the Code or corresponding provision of any future federal tax laws; or (4) gifts to which are deductible for gift tax purposes under Section 2522(a)(2) of the Code or corresponding provision of any future federal tax laws.

### ARTICLE IV Members

The Foundation shall have no members.

### ARTICLE V Board of Directors

The affairs of the Foundation shall be managed by its Board of Directors. The number of directors, terms of office, qualifications and method of election of the directors shall be as specified in the Hylaws.

### ARTICLE VI

These Articles of Incorporation may be smeaded by the directors of the Foundation by vote of a majority of the number of directors in office at the time that the amendment is adopted.

### ARTICLE VII Dissolution

Upon dissolution of the Foundation, the Board of Directors, after making provision for the payment of all of the liabilities of the Foundation, shall arrange for the distribution of all of the assets of the Foundation exclusively for the tax excupt purposes of the Foundation, by distribution to one or more organizations organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational, literary or scientific purposes as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Code or corresponding provision of any future federal tax laws, as the Board of Directors shall determine. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the Superior Court of the County in which the principal office of the Foundation is then located, exclusively for the tax exempt purposes of the Foundation or to such organization or organizations, as such Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
