AUGUST 31, 2011 AND 2010

1. Nature of Activities

Chicago Baseball Cancer Charities, Inc. is organized in the State of Illinois as a not-for-profit organization to raise funds for cancer research and cancer care by promoting celebrity golf outings and raffles in the names of former Chicago baseball personalities. It operates throughout the Chicago metropolitan area in its own name and in northern Indiana as Indiana Sports Charities. Funds raised are allocated to various hospitals and other organizations.

2. Summary of Significant Accounting Policies

<u>Basis of Accounting</u> --- The accompanying financial statements have been prepared on the cash receipts and disbursements basis of accounting, which is a comprehensive basis of accounting other that generally accepted accounting principles. Under that basis, the only transactions recorded are either cash receipts or cash disbursements; non-cash transactions are not recognized.

The cash basis differs from generally accepted accounting principles because the selling prices of some items sold at fundraising auctions and raffles prior to the date of the financial statements, but not collected by that date, are not reflected as accounts receivable.

<u>Investments</u> --- Investments in mutual funds with readily determinable market prices are reported at those values in the statements of assets and net assets. Certificates of deposit are reported at cost; interest on these certificates is recognized only when collected.

<u>Donations of Goods and Services</u> --- Goods offered at auction and as raffle prizes are donated; they are recorded as both receipts and disbursements at their estimated fair market values. Services provided by volunteers do not meet criteria for recognition as contributed services and are therefore not recorded in the financial statements.
