The Patrick Beaver Scholarship Foundation was established to provide full or partial scholarships to high school, college, and/or graduate students who possess the following characteristics:

- 1. An A/B average, or can demonstrate the ability to achieve same to the Foundation Board of Directors, as evidenced by transcripts or presentations to the Board,
- 2. An extraordinary character (i.e., ability to get along with classmates, teachers, professors and administrators) as evidenced by three required written recommendations,
- 3. Focused on an enriching school experience and achieving expected educational goals as evidenced by a required one-page essay, and
- 4. Achievements extracurricular activities both on and off campus.

Special consideration will be given to students having been diagnosed with learning disabilities, living in a disadvantaged home environment, and/or experiencing financial difficulties. Please provide guidance counselor or other official testimony to these conditions. A copy of the FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) report is recommended, if appropriate.

The Foundation will award four new scholarships each spring for the ensuing school year. The scholarship is renewable each year through four years of college as long as the student remains in school and grades remain in good standing. Financial need is a consideration but not a determining factor. Multi-year scholarships require the student providing school transcripts and proof of school registration for the coming semester to the Foundation's office. Summer studies and internships may be funded if the student submits a request, with the full program description, in writing. All scholarships and grants will be at the discretion of the Foundation's Board of Directors, who will select certain candidates to be personally interviewed. The Foundation Board may require additional documentation of a candidate's qualifications at the Board's discretion.

Patrick Beaver's family established this Foundation and serves as the Board of Directors. Patrick was born in Hickory NC on July 22, 1979, and died on Lake Hickory in a boating accident on June 30, 1997. At the time of his death, Patrick was a rising senior at Christ School in Arden, North Carolina, and was maintaining an A/B average in his schoolwork. Many people loved Patrick because of his winning smile and generous personality.
