THE BTA MANAGES A PROGRAM FUNDED BY THE OREGON DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO DISTRIBUTE PEDESTRIAN SAFETY ENFORCEMENT MINI-GRANTS TO POLICE DEPARTMENTS STATEWIDE TO EDUCATE MOTORISTS ABOUT SAFE AND LEGAL DRIVING.

AT THE REGIONAL LEVEL, THE BTA WORKS TO INTEGRATE ACTIVE TRANSPORTATION POLICIES INTO REGIONAL TRANSPORTATION PLANNING, DEVELOP HIGH-QUALITY PLANNING GUIDELINES, AND GROW THE BICYCLE TRAIL NETWORK CONNECTING URBAN AND NATURAL AREAS.

AT THE NATIONAL LEVEL, THE BTA LOBBIES OREGON SENATORS AND REPRESENTATIVES IN CONGRESS TO PASS FEDERAL LEGISLATION THAT SUPPORTS FUNDING FOR ACTIVE TRANSPORTATION AND SAFE ROUTES TO SCHOOL PROGRAMS.
