Its goal is to create and perpetuate financial ort of programs and services on behalf of St. Vincent's Mission to serve the most vulnerable and medically underserved population.

	FY2011, the Foundation contributed \$8,092,261 in support of the St. Vincent's Medical Center master facility project, which included the new Michael J. Daly Center for Emergency and Trauma Care, and the new Elizabeth Pfriem Swim Center for Cancer Care, a state-of-the-art integrative oncology center. An additional \$242,646 donation to the Medical Center helped to subsidize the cost of various Medical Center programs for which there is no other available funding source. One of these programs is the Irma D'Addano Wellness Booth at the Medical Center. During 2011 the Wellness Booth provided free blood pressure checks, and blood sugar and cholesterol screenings. The Foundation also helped subsidize free public lectures on prostate cancer and free prostate screenings for men at risk. The Prostate Cancer Institute sponsors Buddy Network, a peer program, where men who have survived prostate cancer, volunteer to help those newly diagnosed, through sharing their own personal experiences. The Foundation also helped subsidize a health clinic in the "Hollow" section of Bridgeport. The clinic provides healthcare services for the city's working poor, single mothers, and homeless population, who rely on these healthcare services.

	The Foundation's "Swim Across the Sound" campaign provides a source of funds restricted for 45 cancer prevention and cancer support programs. Among these is our mobile mammography program, offering low-cost and free mammography screenings at community based senior centers, churches, synagogues and other local facilities for the medically underserved, at-risk women of southern Connecticut. The Foundation also helped cancer patients and their families through cancer support groups, yoga and massage for cancer patients, Sunday brunches for oncology patients and their families, transportation needs for non-ambulatory cancer patients undergoing treatment, subsidized nausea medication for patients receiving chemotherapy, subsidized purchases of prosthesis and wigs for cancer patients, subsidized at-home hospice assistance, and subsidized nutritional counseling. The Swim also underwrites our Teen Smoke Stoppers program, the only one of its type in Connecticut, is primarily offered through the school systems. During FY2011, approximately 20,272 students attended smoking prevention lectures geared toward teenagers, and 137 students enrolled in smoking cessation classes. During this FY the program was presented in 143 regional middle schools, high schools and colleges.

	During FY2011, the Foundation contributed \$443,806 to the St Vincent's College. The College, a subsidiary of the St Vincent's Medical Center, is committed to reaching out to a broad range of students, especially the poor, working mothers and individuals pursuing career changes. The funds provided by the Foundation enabled the College to grant \$342,071 in scholarships/awards. These scholarships are subject to academic, as well as financial needs criteria. The Foundation also provided funds for an outreach program designed to reach out to middle schools and high schools to prepare interested students, specially minorities, for the healthcare curriculum in college. This outreach program is designed to give minority students the tools to be more successful and to increase diversity in the healthcare workforce.

The Foundation also contributed \$506,289 to the St. Vincent's Special Needs Center primarily for much needed capital repairs at the Feroleto Children's Development Center. Additionally, the Foundation donated \$54,933 to Hall-Brooke Behavioral Health Services. These funds were chiefly used in a new collaborative program that provides diagnostic and treatment services, as well as, continued opportunities for social and cognitive development for children, adolescents and adults with Autism Spectrum Disorders and other related developmental disorders. The Foundation also provided \$50,000 to the United Way of Coastal Fairfield County, for sponsorship of their Feed the Children program.
