The Organization has approximately 40 volunteers helping with one of the fundraising events, the annual auction. Approximately 30 Elks volunteer helping recruit and transport campers. A local business closes it's doors for a day and brings their entire staff, approximately 120 volunteers, for an Annual Volunteer Day, with volunteers working hard to clean up the premises and ready the camp for its busy season. Approximately 30 Elks also join in on the annual Clean-up Day.
