THE DOLLS WERE CREATED IN THE IMAGES OF FAMOUS LEADERS OF VARIOUS ETHNICITIES AND BACKGROUNDS WHO REFLECT THE DEMOCRATIC IDEALS OF EQUALITY AND HUMAN DIGNITY. THE SPECIAL EXHIBITION, "STEAMBOATS TO STEAM ENGINES: GEORGE CALEB BINGHAM'S MISSOURI, 1819-1879", WAS A HIGHLIGHT ATTRACTION FOR VISITORS OF ALL AGES. DURING ITS RUN FROM MARCH 8 THROUGH SEPTEMBER 11, MORE THAN 49,757 VISITORS - INCLUDING 6,728 STUDENTS - VIEWED THIS HISTORIC DISPLAY.
