Expenses

a. Land Acquisition: The North Carolina Coastal Land Trust closed six separate conservation transactions totaling more than 2,500 acres during this fiscal year.

\$5,021,017

The most significant project was Brown's Island, a 600-acre coastal island that is one of the largest remaining undeveloped coastal islands still in private hands. Located near Cape Lookout and Harker's Island, it hosts longleaf pine, hardwood slough and swamps and coastal marsh and a sandy beach—a paradise for wildlife. After a decade of unsuccessful negotiations, the Coastal Land Trust, and the NC Wildlife Resources finally purchased 4 tracts from two different owners, totaling 158 acres of coastal island habitat.

Another important area of success was our "Military Encroachment Partnership" with the US Marine Corps at Cherry Point. In partnership with the Department of Defense, we completed three more projects that have both conservation and military significance. At Luken's Island Phase II, in Carteret County, we raised approximately \$1,275,000 to protect 375 acres beneath training route flyways. We raised \$2,500,000 to protect the final 785 acres at Turnagain Bay, Phase III, also beneath flyways, and \$1,000,000 to protect 1,154 acres at Jarrett's Bay.

Also during the year, the Coastal Land Trust received a donated conservation easement over 59 acres in Currituck County, our first project in that county.

Staff investigated other potential new projects in several priority areas, including the lower Cape Fear River corridor, with our Military Encroachment Partnership, and along the Waccamaw and other rivers.

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#### b. Land Stewardship:

\$202,082

We monitored all of our properties during calendar year 2010. We have posted all properties acquired this year. We resolved two major violations of easements. In the first, a timber cut by an adjoining landowner, we negotiated and received remediation and an appropriate settlement. In the second, the construction of a non-permitted structure, we amended the easement to allow the permitted structure, and disallowed one of the previously permitted structures.

We have removed non-native species (stiltgrasss) at one preserve, and are controlling a different non-native species (English Ivy) at another. We have completed timber thinning work, part of longleaf restoration efforts, at a third property. We have updated forest management plans as needed. We determined the best way to address shoreline erosion at our Springer's Point Preserve, and have secured funding to proceed with a natural shoreline restoration project there.

#### c. Conservation Planning:

\$36,567

North Carolina Coastal Land Trust participates in the Albemarle-Pamlico Conservation and Communities Collaboration, the Cape Fear Arch Conservation Collaboration, and the Onslow Bight Initiative, in which various federal, state and Non-Governmental Organizations interested in protected conservation resources in the Onslow Bight area are pooling resources and personnel. We also participate in the Eastern Forest Coalition and the NC Land Trusts Council. This year we partnered with the State Wildlife Resources Department on the Green Growth Toolbox, to demonstrate how local planning officers can encourage wildlife-friendly habitat. We also partnered with the City of Havelock to identify and negotiate acquisition of recreational tracts. We met with federal and other non-profits as part of the Longleaf Alliance, and we explored the possibility of a new federal refuge on the Waccamaw River.

#### d. Conservation Education:

\$175,214

We had great success with outreach this year. We found individuals and business underwriters to provide funds to host a "Flytrap Frolic" in the City of Wilmington for neighborhood children, which more than 300 people attended. We sponsored an Exhibit on BW Wells at the Cape Fear Museum in Wilmington, which featured historic photos of coastal habitats by the renowned author and naturalist. Most exciting, we hosted a "Family Fun Day at the new Brunswick Nature Park, which exceeded our expectations, when 1,000 kids, parents and friends attended. We introduced participants to kayaking, mountain biking, wildlife demonstrations, face-painting, and tie-dying Tee shirts. We have 40 volunteers from Wal-Mart help us.

We also received excellent press coverage for our acquisitions and outreach. We were featured by Public Radio East, and other radio and TV stations.

The Coastal Land Trust held an Annual Meeting of its members, a "Land Trust Day" in Wilmington and at the Outer Banks, and a golf tournament in Pender County.
