\$132,000 was raised this year to complete the project. The new tomotherapy machine
will deliver a precise beam of radiation and can irradiate cancer cells as small as a
grain of sand while having minimal or no affect on surronding tissues. This new
machine is expected to save or extend the lives of thousands of cancer patients in
the area. In addition to donations for capital projects, the Asante Foundation also
helps support numerous clincial departments at RVMC. This includes a generous
donation of over \$80,000 to the Hospice department. The Dubs Cancer Center received
over \$10,000 of donations and the Francis Cheney Family Place received over \$127,000
