	The Carl Sagan Center for the Study of Life in the Universe (CSC) specializes in the broad interdisciplinary field of astrobiology,
	striving to understand the origin, evolution and distribution of life in the universe. CSC scientists are addressing three of the most
	profound questions in science: How does life arise? Is there life beyond Earth? and What are the future directions for the evolution of
	life? CSC scientists publish the results of their research in peer reviewed journal articles and book chapters & give presentations to
	their colleagues & the public. Many also mentor students, training the next generation of scientists. Examples of some of the exciting research conducted by our scientists in FY 11 are: *Using telescopes & laboratory experiments to understand the complex chemistry
	that takes place in the clouds of gas and dust between the star.*Revealing the strange phenomena that occur in ring systems around
	planets & in the formation process of planets. Exploring remote locations on Earth, from the Arctic to the Antarctic to the Atacama
	Desert to understand the ability of life to adapt to extreme environments. Studying the rapid biological changes on Earth in response
	to climate change as a model to understand the history of habitability on Mars. *Studying planetary systems around other suns being
	discovered by the NASA Kepler Space Telescope. *Probing the surface and subsurface environments on Mars to reveal the history of
	the planet and address the questions of whether life is now, or once was, present there.

	The Center for Education and Outreach (EDU) at SETI Institute conducts projects in formal and informal education and public
	outreach. These projects include curriculum development & teacher professional development, museum exhibit development, and
	outreach to students, teachers and the general public. The Institute is involved in scientific and educational trade shows, workshops,
	and courses which share the Institute scientific research. FY 12 was the sixth year of our Astrobiology Research Experience for
	Undergraduates program, sponsored by the NSF, and third year of our Undergraduate Research at the SETI Institute (URSA)
	collaboration with San Jose State University, a minority serving institution. To date, more than 50% of our REU students are
	pursuing advanced degrees, and several of the URSA interns are enrolled in graduate programs. In FY2012, SETI Institute hosted the second public science and arts convention, SETIcon II, with more than 800 people in attendance. The Institute also hosts a weekly
	scientific colloquium featuring both our scientists, and invited speakers; the talks are posted on YouTube where more than 20,000
	people view the talks each month. Of particular note, SETI Institute hosts a science radio program, "Big Picture Science"
	which reaches millions of listeners world-wide through broadcast and download podcasts. In addition, EDU staff present
	talks nationwide and lead education/outreach programs for NASA's Kepler, SOFIA Missions and NASA's Astrobiology Institute.

	The Allen Telescope Array (ATA) is a unique instrument designed to seek out signals from civilizations elsewhere in the universe
	while simultaneously conducting other radio astronomy research. Science conducted on the array during FY 11 has resulted in
	several published papers and presentations at scientific meetings. Since it is the first telescope of its type, SETI Institute is
	exploring new ideas for commercialization of ATA capabilities for spacecraft downlinks and space situational awareness. The
	ATA is also being used as a testbed for developing new search strategies for extraterrestrial transmitters or discoveries of unusual
	astronomical phenomena. This research program has also generated several papers and presentations.

FORM 990, Part III, Statement of Program Service Accomplishments, line 4d, Program Services: The Center for SETI Research (CSR) is conducting the most comprehensive project dedicated to answering the guestion, "Are we alone?" Astronomers are using the Allen Telescope Array to search for signs of intelligent extraterrestrial life by attempting to detect radio signals from a distant technological civilization. The signal processing is carried out in near-real-time to enterprise services donated by Dell Inc and others. During FY 11 we began a focused sky survey that coordinates with the Kepler Spacecraft, examining thousands of stars where extrasolar planets are thought to exist. Indeed, Kepler's results on exoplanets indicate the probability for SETI success is higher than previously thought. CSR's accomplishments on our setiQuest program have lead to near complete open-sourcing of core SETI search software and the publication of hundreds of raw telescope datasets available for public use. Stemming from the TED award won by Dr. Jill Tarter in 2009, the SETILive program, which allows citizen scientists to participate in SETI in a hands-on way. Each year CSR staff members give dozens of presentations to a variety of audiences in order to inform both their scientific peers and the general public about their work and accomplishments. CSR staff and their work also appeared in countless science documentaries and television and radio programs. The CSR staff published several peer reviewed papers and wrote, or were featured in, many popular articles in FY 11.
