THE AMOUNTS REFLECTED ON PAGE 4 PART VI EXCISE TAX BASED ON INVESTMENT INCOME WAS TO GET THE TAX SOFTWARE TO CALCULATE THE TAX DUE ON THE AMENDED RETURN. NO PENALTY WAS INCLUDED IN THE CALCULATION DUE TO THE SOFTWARE MISCALCULATING THE PENALTY.
