AMENDED AND RESTATED CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION OF SERIOUS FUN CHILDREN'S NETWORK INC.

ARTICLE I NAME

The name of the Corporation is SERIOUS FUN CHILDREN'S NETWORK, INC.

ARTICLE II PURPOSE AND POWERS

The nature or the activities to be conducted and the purposes to be promoted or carried out by the Corporation shall be, in addition to other purposes, to form an association or camps or other facilities or programs established or to be established and to:

- (a) Encourage and help to establish camps, programs or other similar facilities and maintenance of the facilities for children who are emotionally or physically incapacitated or suffering from serious illnesses of any kind. These services shall extend to families and caregivers of children.
- (b) Induce all such camps and programs to join together in this association for the purposes of coordinating their activities, establishing health, recreational, medical, programmatic, governance, financial and other suggested or required standards for the operations of such camps referred to herein.
- (c) Carry on, conduct and exercise all rights and powers authorized for nonstock, nonprofit corporations under the laws of the State of Connecticut which qualifies for Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code status or corresponding sections of the Federal Tax Code.
- (d) Solicit and receive contributions, grants, donations, gifts, bequests, devises and other sources of funding to promote the purposes of the Corporation.
- (e) Make grants, donations and loans, and assist in obtaining grants, donations and loans to or for camps or other organizations or facilities and to assist in locating and establishing camps and programs in areas not presently served.
- (f) Encourage the maintenance of appropriate facilities and standards of all affiliated camps, programs and facilities.
- (g) Accept, hold, invest, reinvest and administer any contributions, grants, donations, gifts, bequests, and devises, received for said purposes.

ARTICLE III NONSTOCK

The Corporation is non-profit and shall not have or issue shares of stock or pay dividends.

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ARTICLE IV NO MEMBERS

The Corporation shall have no members.

ARTICLE V RESTRICTIONS

The Corporation shall (i) be empowered only to engage in activities in furtherance of the above-described exclusively charitable, religious, educational and/or scientific purposes, and (ii) not be empowered to engage in activities that would cause the Corporation to cease to be qualified as exempt under Section 501(a) of the Code as described in Section 501(c)(3) of the Code, or that would cause contributions to the Corporation to cease to be deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Code. The Corporation shall be subject to the following additional restrictions and requirements:

- (1) The Corporation shall not participate in or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. No substantial part of the activities of the Corporation shall constitute the carrying on of propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, except to the extent the Corporation makes expenditures for purposes of influencing legislation in conformity with the requirements of Section 501(h) of the Code.
- (2) For any period during which it is a "private foundation," as defined in Section 509 of the Code, the Corporation shall distribute its income for each taxable year at such time and in such manner as not to become subject to the tax on undistributed income imposed by Section 4942 of the Code. Among the activities in which the Corporation shall not engage for any period during which it is such a "private foundation" are: (i) any act of self-dealing (as defined in Section 4941(d) of the Code); (ii) retaining any excess business holdings (as defined in Section 4943(c) of the Code); (iii) making any investment in such manner as to subject the Corporation to tax under Section 4944 of the Code; and (iv) making any taxable expenditures (as defined in Section 4945(d) of the Code).
- (3) No part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, its officers, directors or other private persons, except that the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered, to reimburse reasonable expenses incurred, to purchase goods and services at reasonable prices, and to provide programs, services and other benefits, all in furtherance of the exclusively charitable, religious, educational, and/or scientific purposes of the Corporation set forth in Article II, and to make distribution of its assets upon dissolution as provided for in Article VI.

ARTICLE VI DISSOLUTION

Upon any dissolution or termination of the existence of the Corporation, all of its property and assets shall, after payment of the lawful debts of the Corporation and the expenses of its dissolution or termination, be delivered, conveyed and paid over to one or more charitable, scientific or educational organizations which qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, as the Board of Directors shall determine which will carry out or further the purposes of this Corporation.

ARTICLE VII LIMITATION OF LIABILTY

To the fullest extent that the Act or any other law of the State of Connecticut, as in effect on the date of this Certificate of Incorporation or as hereafter amended, permits the limitation or elimination of the personal liability of a Director of the Corporation to the Corporation, no Director shall be liable to the Corporation for monetary damages for breach of duty as a Director. No repeal, modification or amendment of this Article VII shall adversely affect any right or protection of a Director of the Corporation existing hereunder with respect to any act or omission occurring prior to such repeal, modification or amendment. Nothing contained in this Article VII shall be construed to deny to the Directors of the Corporation the benefit of Section 52-557m of the Connecticut General Statutes as in effect at the time of the violation (or the corresponding provisions of any subsequent statute amending or replacing said statute), if applicable. The provisions of this Article VII are set forth in this Certificate of Incorporation pursuant to the authority contained in subdivision (4) of subsection (b) of Section 33-1026 of the Act and are intended to limit the liability of the Directors to the Corporation to the greatest extent now or hereafter permitted under the laws of the State of Connecticut."

ARTICLE VIII INDEMNIFICATION

- (a) Right to Indemnification. The Corporation shall indemnify and hold harmless, to the fullest extent permitted by applicable law as it presently exists or may hereafter be amended, any person (an "Indemnitee") who was or is made or is threatened to be made a party to or is otherwise involved in any action, suit or proceeding, whether civil, criminal, administrative or investigative (a "Proceeding"), by reason of the fact that he or she, or a person for whom he or she is a legal representative, is or was a Director or officer of the Corporation, or while a Director or officer of the Corporation, is or was serving at the request of the Corporation as a director, Director, officer, employee or agent of another corporation or of a partnership, limited liability company, joint venture, trust, enterprise or nonprofit entity, including service with respect to employee benefit plans, against all liability (as defined in Section 33-1116 of the Act) and loss suffered by such Indemnitee, and all reasonable expenses (including attorneys' fees) incurred by such Indemnitee, for any action taken, or any failure to take any action, by the Indemnitee. Notwithstanding the preceding sentence, except as otherwise provided in paragraph (c) of this Article VIII, the Corporation shall be required to indemnity an Indemnitee in connection with a Proceeding (or part thereof) commenced by such Indemnitee only if the commencement of such Proceeding (or part thereof) by the Indemnitee was authorized by the Board of Directors of the Corporation.
- (b) Prepayment of Expenses. Subject to the last sentence of paragraph (a) of this Article VIII, the Corporation shall pay the expenses (including attorneys' fees) incurred by an Indemnitee in defending any Proceeding in advance of its final disposition; provided, however, that, to the extent required by law, such payment of expenses in advance of the final disposition of the Proceeding shall be made only upon receipt of (1) a written affirmation of the Indemnitee as required under Section 33-1119 of the Act, and (2) an undertaking by the Indemnitee to repay all amounts advanced if it should be ultimately determined that the Indemnitee is not entitled to be indemnified under this Article VIII or otherwise.
- (c) Claims. Subject to the last sentence of paragraph (a) of this Article VIII, if a claim for indemnification or payment of expenses under this Article VIII is not paid in full within sixty (60) days after a written claim therefore by the Indemnitee has been received by the Corporation, the Indemnitee may file suit to recover the unpaid amount of such claim and, if successful in whole or in part, shall be entitled to be paid the expense of prosecuting such claim. In any such action, the Corporation shall have

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the burden of proving that the Indemnitee is not entitled to the requested indemnification or payment of expenses under applicable law.

- (d) Nonexclusivity of Rights. The rights conferred on any Indemnitee by this Article VIII shall not be exclusive of any other rights which such Indemnitee may have or hereafter acquire under this Certificate of Incorporation or any statute, agreement, bylaw, vote of disinterested Directors or otherwise.
- (e) Other Sources. The Corporation's obligation, if any, to indemnify or to advance expenses to any Indemnitee who was or is serving at its request as a director, Director, officer, employee or agent of another corporation, partnership, limited liability company, joint venture, trust, enterprise or nonprofit entity shall be reduced by any amount such Indemnitee may collect as indemnification or advancement of expenses from such other corporation, partnership, limited liability company, joint venture, trust, enterprise or nonprofit entity.
- (f) Amendment or Repeal. Any repeal or modification of the provisions of this Article VIII shall not adversely affect any right or protection hereunder of any Indemnitee in respect of any act or omission occurring prior to the time of such repeal or modification.
- (g) Other Indemnification and Prepayment of Expenses. This Article VIII shall not limit the right of the Corporation, to the extent and in the manner permitted by law, to indemnify and to advance expenses to persons other than Indemnitees when and as authorized by appropriate corporate action. Without limiting the effect of the foregoing sentence, the Corporation may, if specifically authorized by the Board of Directors of the Corporation, indemnify and advance expenses to any person who is made a party to or is otherwise involved in a proceeding by reason of the fact that he or she, or a person for whom he or she is a legal representative, is or was an employee of the Corporation, or while an employee of the Corporation, of another corporation or of a partnership, limited liability company, joint venture, trust, enterprise or nonprofit entity, including service with respect to employee benefit plans, against all liability (as defined in Section 33-1116 of the Act) and loss suffered by such employee and all reasonable expenses (including attorneys' fees) incurred by such employee for any action taken, or any failure to take any action, by such employee, to the same extent as are provided in this Article VIII and officers of the Corporation.
- (h) Interpretation. The provisions of this Article VIII are set forth in this Certificate of Incorporation pursuant to the authority contained in subdivision (5) of subsection (b) of Section 33-1026 of the Act and are intended to expand the scope of, and make obligatory on the Corporation, the indemnification of Directors and officers of the Corporation to the greatest extent now or hereafter permitted under the laws of the State of Connecticut, and to make permissible for the Corporation the indemnification of employees to the same extent as for Directors and officers.
- (i) Limitation. Notwithstanding any other provision of this Article VIII, if at any time the Corporation is a "private foundation," as defined in Section 509 of the Code, the Corporation shall not, during the period it is such a private foundation, indemnify any person if such indemnity or its carrying out will constitute a violation of any provision of Section 33-281(b) of the Connecticut General Statutes or any substantially like provision which may be contained in this Certificate of Incorporation.
