Foundation Operating Guidelines

- 1. Grants will be made from among applicants submitting proposals for improving the quality of the educational system for Kindergarten through twelfth grade [Grades K-12] within the United States.
- 2. Any individual, organization or institution, domestic or foreign, may submit an application for a grant to the Selection Committee. No person employed by or having an ownership interest in Walden University shall be eligible for a grant.
- 3. The criteria to be used by the Selection Committee in awarding a grant shall be: a) a proposal which in the opinion of the Selection Committee will produce an improvement in the quality of an educational curriculum or system within the United States school system [Grades K-12] nationwide, or within any school district within the United States, and b) the proposal in the opinion of the Selection Committee shall be deemed to be able to produce a significant positive change in the quality of education for Grades K-12. Grants may be awarded to foreign organizations, institutions or individuals provided the applicant demonstrates to the satisfaction of the Committee that the work product of the foreign applicant will directly or indirectly improve the quality of an educational curriculum or system within the United States [Grades K-21].
- 4. Grants will be awarded at such times, in such amounts and upon such terms and conditions as the Selection Committee by unanimous vote shall from time to time determine.
- 5. The Selection Committee shall have four members, including a Director of the Ackerman Foundation, Inc., the President of Walden University, the Director of the Walden University Department for Educational Change and Technical Innovation and a faculty member from the Walden University Department for Educational Change and Technical Innovation, which faculty member shall be selected by the unanimous vote of the other members.
- 6. The Selection Committee shall monitor the grants awarded to the grant recipients, including, but not limited to: 1) approving the proposed budget submitted by each grant recipient, 2) requiring each grant recipient to submit periodic progress reports, at least annually, of its work and its expenditures of grant funds in relation to the work performed, 3) evaluation of each progress report to insure a) that each grant recipient is progressing adequately toward its intermediate and long range goals as stated in its grant application, and b) that the funds granted to each grant recipient are being properly applied to the work for which the grant was made.

- 7. The Selection Committee may recapture funds distributed to any grant recipient which are found by the Committee to have been expended by a grant recipient for purpose other than the work for which the grant was made. The Committee may distribute any grant in installments, as the work progresses, to insure that the work is being done to the satisfaction of the Committee and that the funds are being properly expended by the grant recipient on the work for which the grant was made.
- 8. The Selection Committee may hire such administrative and professional personnel as it deems necessary or advisable to adequately perform the duties and responsibilities of the foundation. The cost of maintaining such administrative and professional personnel shall be paid by the Foundation from its available funds.
