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PROGRAM GUIDELINES

Eligibility

Applicants to the Hannaford Scholarship Program must be:

- Full-time or part-time associates of Hannaford or dependent children* of associates with a minimum of six-months service as of the application deadline date, and
 - *Child is defined as the son, daughter, stepson, stepdaughter, legally adopted child or legal ward supported principally by the associate
- High school seniors or graduates planning to enroll or students already enrolled in a full-time
 course of study leading to a baccalaureate or master's degree at an accredited college or
 university, an associate degree at a junior or community college, or a certificate at an approved
 vocational-technical institute.

Awards

If selected as a recipient, the student will receive an award ranging from \$2,000 to \$5,000 Up to fifty scholarships may be awarded each year.

Awards are not renewable, but students may reapply to the program each year they meet eligibility requirements. Awards are for undergraduate study or graduate study leading to a master's degree.

Application

Interested students must complete the application and mail it along with a current, complete transcript of grades to Scholarship Management Services postmarked no later than **April 1**. Grade reports are not acceptable Online transcripts must display student name, school name, grade and credit hours earned for each course, and term in which each course was taken.

Applicants are responsible for gathering and submitting all necessary information. Applications are evaluated on the information supplied; therefore, answer all questions as completely as possible. Incomplete applications will not be evaluated. All information received is considered confidential and is reviewed only by Scholarship Management Services.

Selection of Recipients

Scholarship recipients are selected on the basis of academic record, leadership and participation in school and community activities, honors, work experience, a statement of educational and career goals, an outside appraisal, and financial need. Financial need as calculated by Scholarship Management Services must be demonstrated for the student to receive an award.

Efforts will be made to ensure that recipients are representative of all areas of the company All other criteria being equal, preference will be given first to associates, then to their children.

Although Hannaford establishes the criteria, selection of recipients is made by Scholarship Management Services. In no instance does any officer or associate of Hannaford or the Hannaford Charitable Foundation play a part in the selection.

Applicants will be notified in early May. Not all applicants to the program will be selected as recipients.

Payment of Scholarships

Scholarship Management Services processes scholarship payments on behalf of the Hannaford Charitable Foundation Payments are made in equal installments on August 15 and December 30

Checks are mailed to each recipient's home address and are made payable to the school for the student.

Obligations

Recipients have no obligation to Hannaford Charitable Foundation. They are, however, required to notify Scholarship Management Services of any changes in address, school enrollment, or other relevant information and to send a complete transcript when requested. Except as described in these guidelines, no obligation is assumed by the Hannaford Charitable Foundation.



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COMPLETING THE FINANCIAL INFORMATION

The Financial Data section of the application should be completed by parents, guardians, or by the applicant if independent. Independent is defined as one who is not claimed as a dependent by the parent/guardian for tax purposes. Information should be from a completed tax return filed with the IRS.

- 1. **State of Residence** is the state where the parents and/or (independent) applicant reside and pay state income tax.
