The Christian boarding school ha 500 students from Kindergarten through Grade 11. Grade 12 will be added in 2012 with the first class graduating in 2013. (2011 were made for both monthly operational expenses and capital expenses associated with the Lower and Upper School detailed listing of the grants and the uses can be found in Schedule F attached to this return. Our organization makes on-son at least an annual basis (normally more often) and requires the Kenyan school to undergo an annual audit by a reputab firm out of Nairobi, Kenya Of particular note, during 2011, the Upper School (grades 9 - 12) classroom building was substant completed with \$143,348 of the grants going for construction of that building. The remaining grant funds were for budgeted monthly operating expenses of \$28,600 and one-time items which arose during the course of the year. The \$1,561 difference expenses and grants were direct expenditures for the Community Health Evangelism outreach program conducted through school.
