The office of grand knight is one that is rich in opportunities to serve his fellow Knights and to lead his council in service to family, Church
and community. The grand knight is primarily responsible for the successful conduct of his council. The grand knight is also the chairman
of the board of trustees of the council, and as such he should make absolutely certain that the records and accounts of the council are
audited semi-annually by the trustees, as required by the laws of the Order. Laws of the Order requires that the grand knight and the trustee
audit the accounts of the financial secretary and treasurer at least every six months, and in January and July report thereon to their council
district deputy, state deputy and the supreme secretary on forms approved by the board of directors and furnished by the Supreme Council.
Based upon financial statements reviewed by board of Directors a Form 990 is developed by a trustee and submitted to outside auditor for
independent review prior to submittal.
The Grand Knight has responsibility to appoint various committees including the Charity committee.
The Charity Committee is responsible for identifying, evaluating, and recommending requests for financial charitable gifts that advance the
mission of the Knights of Columbus. All requests are considered on an individual basis. No donations are considered automatic annual
donations and must be reevaluated annually based upon needs and finances. Consideration is given to those individuals and organziations
