This community center is the base of our rural programs, and houses a small educational computer center, a small primary and high school library, and facilities for cultural and workshop classes in a range of areas including dance and carpentry. This program includes a scholarship program that has grown to over 50 rural high school and community college students, offers subsidized school supplies to low-income rural families, assists a remote primary through high school of 100+ students with seven teachers, assists the rural kinder-garten that we founded in 2001, and runs a small educational urban computer center with Internet, for low income urban and rural students.
