Part VI - Section B - 11A - The trustees are given a copy of the Form 990 to review before being filed and signed by the President/Trustee.
Part VI - Section B - 12C - Once a year our "Conflict of Interest Policy" is given to all trustees. All trustees are required to read the policy
and sign to the fact they have read and will comply with the policy.
