We have audited the balance sheet (Part X) of Teamsters Local Union 493 as of December 31, 2011, and the related statement of revenue, expenses and changes in net assets (Part I) and the statement of functional expenses (Part IX) for the year then ended included in the accompanying Internal Revenue Service Form 990. These financial statements are the responsibility of the Union's Executive Board. Our responsibility is to express an opinion on these financial statements based on our audit.

We conducted our audit in accordance with auditing standards generally accepted in the United States of America. Those standards require that we plan and perform the audit to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the financial statements are free of material misstatement. An audit includes examining, on a test basis, evidence supporting the amounts and disclosures in the financial statements.
