During the year ended December 31, 2011 this return was originally extended from its original due date (May 15, 2012) to August 15, 2012. During July of 2012, the Controller of the company quit. This was the 2nd year in a row that there were difficulties with internal personnel. As soon as the information was obtained, the returns were prepared and filed. The accounting for this entity has now been transferred to a company with a large professional staff. All future returns will be filed timely.
