This is especially true for young people who we assist with healthy personal development and growth by offering programs in classrooms, places of faith, scouts, youth programs and other youth settings using, in part, Native American storytelling and Medicine Wheel Programs; and
- 2) to assist the Lakota/Sioux Indians in South Dakota with emphasis on the Cheyenne River Lakota/Sioux Indian Reservation to meet their basic human needs arising out of America's worst poverty. This includes distribution of holiday gift boxes to some 3,000 children, repairing homes of Elders and people with disabilities, renovating community buildings, assisting with emergencies including weather related disasters, support for Tribal and community programs including Veterans, Elders, children, and families, sponsoring medical and dental clinics and providing supplies and equipment for medical/disabilities needs.

Key to our work is helping young people and adults reconnect to community and gain personal power through understanding that they can make a difference in the world around them by volunteering. Substance abuse and other risky behavior avoidance is key to our youth focus. We also receive funding from various school districts in Connecticut to provide diversity education programs, violence prevention through our PeaceWorks program and bonding for moms and daughters through the Four Generations of Women program.

In 2011, we served in Connecticut over 3,000 children from pre-school through high school and some 3,500 adults including college students, faith communities, businesses and more. We also provided educational programs to adult groups including staff trainings in diversity, cross-cultural understanding and community mobilization.

On the Reservation, we served some 2,600 children and some 1,200 adults. Among the direct services, was the provision of a week-long medical clinic focused on women's health which served some 100 women and children and a small number of adult males.

The Twelfth Annual Holiday Give Away:

A key part of *hawkwing's* mission is to assist the people of the Lakota/Sioux nation to meet their basic needs arising out of extreme poverty. The Reservations of South Dakota are literally the poorest places in America with conditions that rival third world nations. The founder of *hawkwing*, Rochelle Ripley, is of Lakota descent and is strongly committed through the Agency to assist the tribes to regain economic self-sufficiency, cultural

recognition and respect, and physical and emotional health. The focus is presently on the Cheyenne River Sioux Reservation in north central South Dakota. The Reservation is home to over 10,000 Lakota Sioux people and is approximately the size of the state of Connecticut. By US Census, it is the poorest place in America (US Census 2000 and 2010).

hawkwing conducts an annual Give Away each year at the holidays in December for new items for children and Elders of the tribe. We also assist the tribal programs and schools. In 2011, the Twelfth Annual Give Away was held – delivering nearly about \$290,600 of donated goods. We served 2,200 children from birth through 18 years and 500 Elders age 60 and older. The children each received a gift box containing school supplies, new books and toys, five to seven new clothing items and eight personal care items. On average, each child's box was valued at \$80.00. Elders received various items including blankets, coats, shoes, and personal care products. The overall value was about \$12,000. Tribal programs received another \$40,000 worth of medical supplies, walkers, crutches, wheelchairs and other supplies. We were also able to assist the Veterans in stocking their new homeless shelter with kitchen items, food and blankets. These are valued at \$1,000.

Through a corporate partnership with Bed, Bath and Beyond, we were able to deliver critically needed household products such as blankets, bedding, kitchenware and more, valued at about \$55,000. These were distributed to those most in need through the Community Health network including families, Elders, veterans and the disabled. We also received about \$1,000 of household building supplies from Home Depot and some \$1,000 worth of household products from William Sonoma.

Cash value for the Twelfth Annual Give Away as listed above is listed at \$290,600. In addition, there were in-kind services at \$2,500 for travel team, \$10,000 in shipping from Connecticut, and volunteers packing boxes and loading truck at \$16,400 (820 hours work at \$20/hour) valued together at \$28,900. Also included for in-kind is \$12,000 a year for donated warehouse space. The total of cash and in-kind donations were \$331,500.

Third Annual Helping Hands and Initial Medical Mission:

During June of 2011, we provided medical services estimated at \$43,250 in medical exams, supplies and travel. Five medical professionals and one support staff worked with the Tribal Women's Health Services for the week long clinic. Our staff also conducted an-all staff training for some 40 tribal staff on nutrition, holistic practices and medicines. This is valued at \$1,500. Among testing done were heavy metals assays which revealed high levels of aluminum, lead and thorium – a derivative of uranium exposure.

In addition, we delivered to Head Start \$5,200 in school equipment, books and toys from a pre-school program in Connecticut which had to close its doors. Head Start had lost its building and all educational materials, furniture and office equipment in a fire and was operating in temporary space. In addition, we delivered office supplies donated for tribal programs by Health Care.

Due to extreme heat in the summer of 2011, we were able to provide \$2,200 worth of air conditioners for those most in need – the Elders and those with illness/disabilities as requested by the energy assistance and medical offices. We were also able to leverage a low cost partnership with Lowe's and Whirlpool to purchase another \$10,000 worth of air conditioners at a savings off of retail of some \$22,000.

We provided the opportunity for families to have family portraits made through a volunteer professional photographer. Some 40 families received framed portraits through this project – many of whom could not afford these services commercially and many of which were intergenerational shoots. This is valued at \$3,410.

We also conducted our annual construction project through Helping Hands involving 9 volunteers with significant skills including a professional electrician. They repaired and assessed needs with five families and repaired the roof on the tribal cultural center which houses historic items and pictures as well as serving as the tourism center. The roof was badly leaking with garbage cans placed throughout to capture water running into the center. Costs for the construction services came to \$22,950. In addition is the donated shipping (full sized semi) at the value of \$10,000.

Some of these volunteers also continued our work in Bear Creek where as part of the Riverside Church funding, organic gardens were established with the community's youth. Gardeners were provided with instruction, gloves, garden implements, organic soil and seeds and burlap bags to serve as planting sites. The soil quality and arability are extremely poor requiring gardens contained within raised beds. The burlap bags were an easy and effective way to provide these. Costs for this project were \$920.

Total value for Medical Mission and Helping Hands is estimated at \$121,430 of both direct and in-kind services.

Support for Fundraising:

In May, we conducted the third Annual Moccasin Walk fundraiser to leverage funds for a housing rehabilitation and repair project during the summer titled Helping Hands. We raised \$8,242 in cash donations. We also held our first annual Concert of Hope starring Grammy Award winner Joseph Fire Crow. During the concert, we also held a silent auction. Together, the event and auction raised about \$10,182. We raised a total of \$18,424 toward the summer medical mission and construction project. We also solicited our donor base in the fall for our Annual Drive as well as on-going solicitation of new and existing donors and raised another \$35,000. Additionally, we are receiving donations for the bookmarks produced for hawkwing in the amount of \$2,764.

For donations of goods for the projects include over \$183,000 in clothing, toys, new books and personal care products. Additionally, we had donations of approximately 1,200 gently used coats (valued at \$5 each) valued at \$6,000 and 130 new coats (value \$20 each) to total \$2,600. We received household items valued at \$3,000. We had 12 groups knit for the children and the Elders from 6 different states producing some 800 items at an average value

of \$15 each for a total of \$12,000. We received over \$5,000 in donated nursery school supplies and equipment. Medical donations from organizations/individuals totaled \$10,000.

Libraries:

To assist with literacy, *hawkwing* began a library program for students in late 2004 which expanded significantly in 2005 and has continued to grow each year. Working collaboratively with Reading Well for Kids in Meriden, CT, we continue to add to the existing eight sites for library access as well as expanding to the Cultural Center as the ninth site. Many children, anxious to have access to reading materials, ask to keep the books they take home. We are adding a used book component to the Cultural Center Library to allow children to pick from some books that they can keep in addition to those they return on loan. We estimate that there are some 14,000 volumes in circulation among the sites. This year we added another 4,000 gently used books valued at \$0.50 each for a total of \$2,000.

Community Service/Volunteerism:

hawkwing is very proud of its level of mobilized volunteerism. We are firmly rooted in volunteer efforts promoting involvement of youth and adults in all aspects of the Agency both in Connecticut and on the Cheyenne River Sioux Reservation. All educational and cultural programs include donations for the Give Away usually in the form of donated new items. Thousands of adults and youth participate in small and large ways each year including organizing, collecting new items and cash drives, delivering donations to the warehouse, warehouse organizing, packing of each child's gift package, loading a full sized semi-truck each December to go to South Dakota and again in the summer for Helping Hands, unloading on the Reservation end, packaging "totem necklaces" as program supplies for over 6,000 participants each year, mission projects, producing bookmarks for donations, traveling to the Reservation with the Give Away and Helping Hands trips, corporate outreach, office organization, publicity and fundraising. Warehouse space is donated by the Town of Glastonbury, CT. Shipping costs are donated by World Fulfillment Logistics of Plainville, CT. We are staffed with only 1.5 full time equivalent people as volunteers. All tasks and services are provided by our volunteers – one staff received this year a small stipend of \$6,000 from a grant which offered income for coordination. Our accounting, website maintenance and graphics designs are provided pro bono as in kind service donations for a total value of \$4,800.
