THE PROGRAM HAS PROVIDED FARM PLANNING AND MARKET DEVELOPMENT SERVICES TO MORE THAN 600 FARMS, AND ASSISTED MORE THAN 90 FARMERS' MARKETS TO UNDERSTAND BEST PRACTICES, PROMOTE THEMSELVES, AND NAVIGATE THE REGULATORY ENVIRONMENT.
