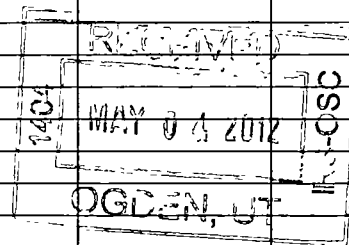

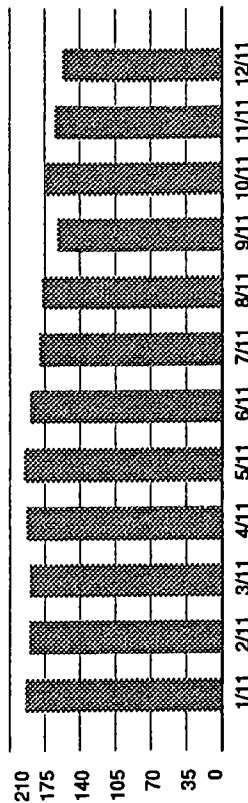

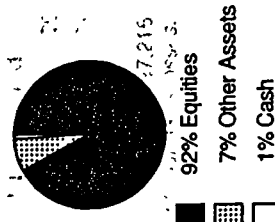
Account Value (\$) Over Last 12 Months [in Thousands]
