2011 Camargo Foundation Programs and Events

In 2011, the Camargo Foundation, which maintains a study center in Cassis, France, hosted residencies during one academic semester for 12 Camargo Fellows, who were individual scholars, artists, composers and writers. This was the 40th consecutive year that the Foundation had welcomed Fellows in Cassis. The Foundation also continued a long tradition of hosting cultural events in its facilities for the local community.

As in the past, selection committees in each of the Foundation's four program areas chose Fellows from applications received via an on-line process. These committees had met in New York City in March 2010 to recommend the Fall 2010-Spring 2011 Fellows and alternates from over 400 applicants. They made their selections independently, without input from the Foundation board and staff, based on previous accomplishments of applicants, the description of the specific project on which they would work while at Camargo, and letters of recommendation. The Camargo board of trustees reviewed and ratified the choices of the selection committees. Camargo Fellows in 2011 were offered a \$1500 stipend, which Fellows having adequate funds from other sources, like sabbatical pay, were asked to waive voluntarily, and several did.

The 2011 Fellows came mainly from the United States, but also from the UK and Italy, and represented diverse but often related areas of expertise, thus creating opportunities for interdisciplinary exchange. They were on-site, as required, for the entirety of their residency, with brief exceptions for professional obligations like conferences, and except during French school holidays. While at Camargo, Fellows had access to the Foundation library as well as to other resources available on-line. Foundation staff followed the Fellows' progress while they were resident at Camargo. Attendance at weekly project presentations by Fellows was mandatory, and the end of their residency, Fellows provided the Foundation with summaries of the progress they had made on the projects while at Camargo. These are posted online at camargofoundation.org

The Foundation provided Fellows with guest speakers, access to cultural events, excursions to Marseille and Arles, movie nights, and activities organized by colleagues and residents of Cassis.

It has been the policy of the Foundation to make its facilities available on a selective basis to groups whose activities are consonant with the Foundation's mission. In 2011, for the 23rd year, the Foundation hosted during the last weekend in April and the first weekend in May the annual book festival called *Printemps du Livre* in association with local authorities. In August it lent its outdoor theatre to a dance troupe. The Foundation also hosted an end-of-semester presentation of Fellows' work.

The Foundation's endowment having been negatively affected by the stock market decline in 2008 and also by adverse exchange rates, it suspended its program as of the 2011-2012 academic year to permit the board to decide on the foundation's future. In November 2011 the Foundation announced that as its deliberations were ongoing, it was extending the suspension of the program, and thus the selection process, for another year, and that there would be no Fellows for the 2012-2013 academic year.
