Program staff are assigned to each proposal, and serve to assist the organization throughout the proposal process.

In 2011, the Foundation discovered that an employee of a professional service advisor had embezzled \$108,660 during 2010 and 2011. Immediately upon discovering the embezzlement, the Foundation hired legal counsel to coordinate the Foundation's internal investigation of the embezzlement, to pursue recovery of the Foundation's funds and its costs, and to act as a liaison with law enforcement officials. The Foundation has recovered all amounts stolen from it. The professional service provider no longer provides services to the Foundation and the Foundation has instituted internal controls and other precautionary safeguards.

The Foundation has confirmed that a portion of the amount embezzled, \$82,200, was erroneously reported as grants to qualified charities on its 2010 Form 990-PF. As a consequence, the Foundation is re-stating its 2010 qualifying distribution carryover reflected in Part XIII to subtract such amounts along with other adjustments, as reflected in the attachment to Part XIII. Part V has also been restated to report the correct amount of qualifying distributions for 2010 and to include the value of an asset improperly omitted from Part X calculations in 2006-2010. A total of \$16,460 was repaid during 2010 prior to the discovery of the embezzlement and was not misrepresented as a qualifying distribution in the Foundation's financial statements. Likewise, the \$10,000 embezzled during 2011 has not been reported as a qualifying distribution in this return. Notwithstanding the embezzlement and misstatement of expenses, there was no impact to the Foundation under Sections 4942 and 4940 of the Code. The Foundation determined that in 2010 it was not liable for a tax on undistributed income under Section 4942 and likewise it continued to qualify for the lesser 1% tax on net investment income under Section 4940(e) of the Code, even after the aforementioned adjustments.

As indicated in Part VII-B, the Foundation has filed a Form 4720 for 2010 and 2011 in regards to amounts embezzled.
