#### **2011 PROGRAM ACCOMPLISHMENTS**

#### **GRANTMAKING**

In 2011, Third Wave granted \$283,000 to organizations that are led by and focus on young people in communities that are most impacted by social inequity in the U.S. Third Wave's grantee partners advance issues that are central to achieving justice for young women, transgender, and gender non-conforming youth. To that end, we primarily support organizations that serve as models for cross-movement collaboration that engage in community organizing, advocacy, research, and providing holistic services where the social safety net has faltered. Third Wave made grants to twenty organizations under the following dockets: Reproductive Health and Justice, Freedom from Violence, and Empowered Leaders.

Our **Gender Justice Initiative** combines funding, capacity building, and convening to support new leadership and strategies that:

- Support young women and transgender youth and their organizations to create change in their communities;
- Ensure young women and transgender youth have the skills, power, and opportunity to engage in and lead efforts for social justice;
- Strengthen progressive movements by investing in the next generation of leadership;
- Help grow the women's movement by supporting new and innovative approaches to pursuing gender, racial, social, and economic justice;
- Increase the number of foundations giving to organizations led by young women and transgender individuals, while also increasing the amount these organizations give;
- Advance proactive political and social changes through intentional support of a network of youth-focused organizations;
- Engage new communities in organizing around these issues; and
- Connect local, state, and national organizations and campaigns so that the grassroots can effectively
  engage and impact the direction of national policy advocacy organizations.

#### Together, our grant partners are:

Shifting funding and policies that prioritize abstinence-only programs to those that advance evidence-based, comprehensive sex education: This includes development of community-based sex education programs that center the experiences and needs of young women and transgender youth, as well as youth-led sex education policy advocacy to address the stigmatization of LGBTQ youth and young parents. With our support, young people are also addressing related issues of educational inequity to create more affirming and safe environments in their schools.

Providing culturally competent, community-based models of care, where there is limited access or high levels of stigma: Third Wave's grant partners create and implement transformative services such as culturally competent service, health education, and health care provision linked with advocacy. In addition to filling a critical gap in local health infrastructure, this builds political capacity for our people. As young women and transgender youth are disproportionately impacted by HIV/AIDS and, historically, have been marginalized or stigmatized by health policy frameworks, Third Wave invests in grassroots organizations led by the people most impacted by social and health inequities who are creating models of care that offer quality care and respect.

Advancing a rights-based approach to empowering young people: Third Wave grantee partners are at the vanguard of creating safe and empowering spaces in which young people experiencing multiple oppressions can develop their leadership and find community. In 2010, Third Wave intentionally increased our support of young people who have life experience in sex work and the sex trade, in light of a growing national movement to classify all sex work done by young people as trafficked, regardless how they may describe their experience. This conflation of all sex work with trafficking undermines young people's agency and dilutes the availability of resources for people who have actually been trafficked. Third Wave believes that young people are best positioned to name their experiences and design their own solutions to injustice in locations such as the educational, criminal justice, or healthcare systems, and in both the formal or informal economy.

Building community responses to violence that don't rely on the criminal/legal system: Our grant partners are using community organizing and education strategies to address systemic and interpersonal forms of violence. They are organizing LGBTQ sexual assault survivors, low-income communities of color, and currently and formerly incarcerated women and transgender youth to address violence and create solutions that limit the prison industrial complex.

#### **LEADERSHIP DEVELOPMENT**

Third Wave held one national **convening of our reproductive justice network** that works to increase the impact and visibility of youth-led gender justice organizations working in various sectors. At convenings current and former Third Wave grant partner organizations have the opportunity to join with politically aligned organizations to reflect, strategize, and rejuvenate. Together, they are able to identify key opportunities to support each other in learning new skills for organizational practice and leveraging new contacts and strategies for campaigns.

At the **2011 Convening**, we gathered 24 organizations from 12 states that make up our Reproductive Health and Justice Initiative docket in Albuquerque, NM to share their stories and strategies with each other in a unique, mixed-methods space that was designed by Third Wave to encourage peer learning and provide participants with opportunities to demonstrate individual and organizational leadership. The Lab was developed through surveys on desired peer-learning outcomes as well as skills that individuals and organizations already had and wanted to share with the group. Participant-led workshops included: Managing our Peers, Organizational Structures, How We Use Creativity in our Work, Sustaining Ourselves, Networks 101, Power Mapping, Facilitating Through Internal Conflict, and Stages of Campaign Development.

#### **CAPACITY BUILDING**

In 2011, Third Wave provided significant capacity-building supports to our grantee partners, specifically around financial health. We partnered with Carol Cantwell of Fun with Financials to offer a financial health webinar to over 20 RHJI current and former grantee partners. Carol also provided follow-up technical assistance for one year after the webinar to 6 organizations. We also hosted an exchange in which our grant partners submitted questions that they always wanted to ask program officers and had program officers from different types of foundations answered their questions. This call was useful because many of our grant partners do not have enough guidance when it comes to engaging with foundations.

#### **PHILANTHROPIC ADVOCACY**

As a publicly supported foundation working at the intersection of philanthropy and social justice, we recognize and value partnerships between donors and activists as a key to youth development, organizing, and a better future. Our philanthropic advocacy work is about educating and collaborating with donors on the opportunities and barriers that exist for youth in social justice work and moving critical resources to solutions that young people have created.

Third Wave continues to lead conversations about young people's engagement within women's and reproductive rights funding circles. We do this within several affinity groups and communities, including the Funders Network on Population, Reproductive Health and Rights, the Women's Funding Network, and Funders for LGBTQ Issues. Within these spaces, we have successfully increased the visibility of youth-led work through organizing panels at conferences, the formation of and participation in related working groups, and holding the line in critical conversations.
