StoryCorps touched millions more through our award-winning broadcasts, which give a broad audience the opportunity to engage with powerful, authentic, and though-provoking stories told by everyday people. Through NPR's Morning Edition, we shared select, edited stories with approximately 14 million listeners each week. Our third book, All There Is: Love Stories From StoryCorps, was released and debuted on the New York Times bestseller list. In addition, StoryCorps received a Peabody Award for its story collection and Animated Shorts to commemorate the Tenth Anniversary of the September 11, 2011 terrorist attacks. As an organization, StoryCorps has a strict commitment to diversity and dedicates over 25% of interview slots to community partnership with organizations representing immigrant populations, religious and ethnic minorities, at-risk economic groups, and other underserved communities. Working through these organizations allows StoryCorps to move beyond the barriers that might prohibit these groups from taking part in the StoryCorps experience and to engage a non-public radio listening audience. In 2011 we recorded stories in partnership with some 500 community organizations throughout the country. In addition, StoryCorps' initiatives reach out to targeted populations to fulfill our commitment to record as diverse an array of voices as

The National Teachers Initiative, in its first year, celebrates the brilliant and courageous work of public school teachers across the country.

By recording, sharing, and preserving their stories, we hope to call public attention to the invaluable contributions teachers have made to this nation, honor those who have embraced the profession as their calling, encourage teaching as a career choice, and unify the country behind its teachers.

The Legacy Initiative continues to collect, preserve, and share the stories of people with life-threatening conditions. Embarking on its third year, the initiative has expanded to include different types of organizations, such as pediatric programs to extend the Legacy storytelling experience to the children, adolescents, and families they serve.
