NOTE 1. SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Nature of Activities

The E. Matilda Ziegler Foundation For The Blind, Inc. (the "Foundation") was created to provide support for programs and research for the amelioration of the blind. It is also the sole source of funding for The Matilda Ziegler Publishing Company For The Blind, Inc. (the "Company"). In 2009 and 2010, the Company reorganized its production and distribution efforts so that it now benefits the blind through materials and publications placed on the internet.

The Foundation relies on the income generated from its investment portfolio and does not solicit contributions from the public.

Basis of Presentation

Financial statement presentation requires that the Foundation report information regarding its financial position and activities according to three classes of net assets: unrestricted net assets, temporarily restricted net assets, and permanently restricted net assets.

Basis of Accounting

The Foundation maintains its books on the modified cash basis of accounting and its expenses are reported in the period incurred rather than paid. Dividends and interest are recorded as income when received.

Cash and Cash Equivalents

For the purpose of the statement of cash flows, the Foundation considers all highly liquid debt instruments purchased with an original maturity of three months or less to be cash equivalents.

Investments

The Foundation carries investments at fair market value. Unrealized gains and losses are included in the change in net assets in the statement of activities on a modified cash basis. See Note 7 for a discussion of fair value measurement.

Restrictions on Net Assets

Temporarily restricted net assets provide an endowment to generate income from investments to award grants and support the Foundation. Net proceeds from the disposition of investments are reinvested in the investment portfolio. A portion of excess funds resulting from dispositions at times is made available for the Foundation's operating purposes.

NOTE 1. SUMMARY OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES (Continued)

Use of Estimates

Financial statement preparation in conformity with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America requires management to make estimates and assumptions that affect the reported amounts of assets and liabilities and disclosure of contingent assets and liabilities at the date of the financial statements and the reported amounts of revenues and expenses during the reporting period. Actual results could differ from those estimates.

NOTE 2. TAX STATUS

The Internal Revenue Service has determined that the Foundation is exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Code. The Code imposes an excise tax of 2% (reduced to 1% if certain requirements are met) on the net investment income of private foundations.

Current federal tax regulations require that a portion of the excess of revenues over expenses be distributed within one year for qualifying purposes. As of December 31, 2011 there was a total of \$152,648 excess distributions carried over to 2012.

The Foundation files its 990-PF in the federal jurisdiction and the office of the state's attorney general for the State of New York. The Foundation's federal Return of Private Foundation (Form 990-PF) is generally subject to examination by the IRS for three years after it is filed.

NOTE 3. RELATED PARTY TRANSACTIONS

Periodic grants are paid to The Matilda Ziegler Publishing Company For The Blind, Inc. to meet the expenses of maintaining its operations. Grants paid during the year ended December 31, 2011 totaled \$60,000. The Foundation and Publishing Company share common directors and officers.

NOTE 4. CONCENTRATION OF CREDIT RISK

The Foundation maintains its cash balances with one financial institution. The balances are insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation up to \$250,000. At December 31, 2011, the Foundation's uninsured cash balances total \$0.

NOTE 6. COMMITMENTS

In December 1999, the Foundation entered into an agreement with Bank of America, formerly known as Fleet Bank, appointing them custodian of its investment accounts. Either party was able terminate this agreement upon thirty days written notice. Compensation for services rendered was payable on a quarterly basis based on net principal value of the assets of the investments. This agreement was terminated with the closing of the Foundation's last custodial account effective August, 2011.

The Foundation contracted with Evaluation Associates International to oversee the Organizations assets and make recommendations based on portfolio allocation and current market conditions. The quarterly fee for these services is \$6,250. During 2003, Evaluation Services International was purchased by Milliman USA and in 2011 Evaluation Associates International changed its name to Mercer Investment Consulting, Inc.

NOTE 6. COMMITMENTS (Continued)

In June 2010, the Foundation entered into a subscription agreement with Income Research & Management to invest in IR & M Core Bond Fund LLC. The management fees for these services are payable at .39% of the fair market value of the assets managed. The Foundation may withdraw all or a portion of its account as of the last business day of a calendar month with a minimum of five business days prior notice to the fund's management.

NOTE 7. FAIR VALUE MEASUREMENTS

The Foundation's investments are reported at fair value in the accompanying statement of financial position. The methods used to measure fair value may produce an amount that may not be indicative of net realizable value or reflective of future fair values. Furthermore, although the Foundation believes its valuation methods are appropriate and consistent with other market participants, the use of different methodologies or assumptions to determine the fair value of certain financial instruments could result in a different fair value measurement at the reporting date.

The fair value measurements authoritative literature establishes a fair value hierarchy that prioritizes the inputs to valuation techniques used to measure fair value. This hierarchy consists of three broad levels: Level 1 inputs consist of unadjusted quoted prices in active markets for identical assets and have the highest priority, Level 2 inputs consist of observable inputs other than quoted prices for identical assets, and Level 3 inputs have the lowest priority.

During the year ended December 31, 2011, no hedge fund securities were transferred out of or into Level 1. Securities with a total value of \$71,202 were transferred out of Level 2 and into Level 3 and securities with a total value of \$24,919 were transferred into Level 2 from Level 3 due to a change in the pricing sources. The new source could have different inputs and applied methodology than the original source. Transfers are recognized on the date of the event which causes the change in the inputs to valuation techniques.

Hedge fund ("the Fund") securities are valued at fair value on each Adjustment Date which is defined in the Fund's LLC Agreement as the last business day of each calendar month or the day immediately preceding the date on which any capital is contributed, distributed or withdrawn from the Fund. The Fund principally utilizes independent pricing services to value its securities but may also use prices from dealers who make markets in such securities.

When current market prices or quotations are not readily available or the Fund's manager believes that such prices or quotations do not accurately reflect fair value, valuations may be determined in good faith by the manager who will consider factors such as market or security specific events, changes in interest rates and credit quality.

The Fund categorizes the inputs to valuation techniques used to value its securities into a disclosure hierarchy consisting of the three levels previously described in this Note above.
