PART XV - 2a-d - Information Regarding Grant, Loan, and Scholarship Programs

#### Scholarship Program

٠.

The Puckett Foundation, which was established by B. Earl Puckett, is awarding a scholarship to help a promising graduate of Fairfield Community High School obtain a quality college education. Mr. Puckett always stressed the necessity for a solid background and training for any type of career.

- 1. Scholarship is for a period of four years.
  - a. The scholarship will be terminated if the recipient does not maintain a passing average.
  - b. In case the student must discontinue schooling, for unavoidable reasons, during the four year period, the scholarship may be reinstated, at the discretion of the Puckett Foundation.
- 2. The scholarship is to be awarded to a graduating senior of the Fairfield Community High School.
- 3. The scholarship will be awarded on the basis of scholarship, ability, industry and integrity.
- 4. Application for the scholarship must be made to the High School Guidance Office by March 1.
- 5. Applicant must meet the following criteria:
  - a. Have a minimum ACT score of 19.
  - b. Have a 4.0 or better Grade Point Average
  - c. Rank in the upper 25% of his/her class.
- 6. The selection of the recipient of the scholarship will be made by the faculty of the Fairfield Community High School by April 1.
- 7. Recipient of the scholarship will be notified of his/her selection by April 15.
- 8. The Trustee of the Puckett Foundation will pay to the recipient one-half of the scholarship by July 1, and the other half by December 1, providing that he/she is enrolled in college.

#### PART XV - 2a-d - Information Regarding Grant, Loan, and Scholarship Programs

The Puckett Foundation will award one new scholarship each year during a period of five years, from 1980 through 1984 inclusive. After 1984, continuance of new 4-year scholarships will be at the discretion of the Advisory Council of the Puckett Foundation. Whatever decision is made by the Advisory Council as to continuing the awarding of new scholarships after 1984, the 4-year scholarships already awarded 1980-84, inclusive, will be honored for the full four years

The Puckett Foundation makes grants and loans to entities, in the United States or any possessions of the United States, organized and operating exclusively for religious, charitable, scientific, literary, or educational purposes or for the prevention of cruelty to children or animals.
