Note 1 - Nature of Activities and Summary of Significant Accounting Policies

A. Activity

Greater Ithaca Activities Center, Inc (the Organization) is a New York not-for-profit Corporation. The Organization was formed to provide multicultural, educational and recreational programs focusing on social and individual development. The Organization provides programs for youth, teen and adult participants.

B. Accounting Method

The Organization's policy is to prepare financial statements on the cash basis of accounting. Consequently, contributions and other revenues are recognized when received rather than when promised or earned, and expenses and purchases of assets are recognized when cash is disbursed rather than when the obligation is incurred.

C. Financial Statement Presentation

The Organization complies with the provisions of Statement of Financial Accounting Standards (SFAS) No. 117, "Financial Statements of Not-for-Profit Organizations," which is now incorporated in the Financial Accounting Standards Board (FASB) Accounting Standards Codification (ASC) 958 "Not-for-Profit Entities." Under FASB ASC 958, the Organization is required to report information regarding its financial position and activities according to three classes of net assets. unrestricted net assets, temporarily restricted net assets and permanently restricted net assets.

D Use of Estimates

The preparation of financial statements in conformity with the cash basis of accounting requires management to make estimates and assumptions that affect certain reported amounts and disclosures in the financial statements. Actual results could differ from those estimates.

E Contributions

The Organization accounts for contributions in accordance with the recommendations of the FASB in SFAS No. 116, "Accounting for Contributions Received and Contributions Made," which is now incorporated in the FASB ASC 958 "Not-for-Profit Entities." Under FASB ASC 958, contributions received are recorded as unrestricted, temporarily restricted or permanently restricted support depending on the existence or nature of any donor restrictions.

F. Cash and Cash Equivalents

Cash and cash equivalents include all highly liquid debt instruments purchased with a maturity of three months or less.

G. Equipment

Equipment is stated at cost. Depreciation is computed on the straight-line method over the estimated useful lives of the assets.

H. Income Taxes

The Organization is a nonprofit organization as described in Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code and is exempt from federal and state income taxes. The Organization's federal income tax returns for 2008, 2009 and 2010 are subject to examination by the IRS, generally for three years after they were filed. In addition, the Organization's state tax returns for the same years are subject to examination by state tax authorities for similar time periods.

Net Assets

Net assets of the Organization are reported as unrestricted. Unrestricted net assets may be used by the Organization to support continuing operations. Classification of net assets is described previously in these notes.

Note 2 - Cash Concentration

The Organization places cash deposits and temporary cash investments in one financial institution. The balances are insured by the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation (FDIC). Cash balances may routinely exceed FDIC insurance limits.

Note 3 - In-kind Support

Under an agreement with the City of Ithaca (the City), dated April 7, 2004, the Organization occupies a facility owned, operated and maintained by the City. In addition, the agreement designates the City as the employer of record of the Organization's director and supporting staff. The agreement renews automatically on an annual basis unless terminated by either party with proper notice.
