- · Current organizational budget.
- . Measurable goals and objectives of the project.

In addition to the above information, applicants will be required to attach or mail the following documents:

 organization that is not a private foundation.
- A copy of the most recently audited financial statements.
- A copy of the organization's most recent Form 990-Income Tax Return of organization exempt from income tax certified by a Certified Public Accountant.
